## **Classroom Discipline Plan**

"Teachers have the right to teach; students have the right to learn!"

In order to guarantee all students in my classroom the excellent learning climate they deserve, I am utilizing this discipline plan starting today.

I believe all students can behave appropriately in my classroom. I will not allow any student to stop me from teaching and/or any student from learning.

- I. Behavior rules for my classroom:
  - A. Respect other students and their property in a way you would expect me to respect you and your property.
  - B. Be on time, bring all required materials to class, and do your own work. It is the only way you will learn anything.
  - C. No vulgar language or vandalism will be tolerated.
  - D. Do not bring food or drinks into this program.
  - E. No cell phones or other electronics devices will be displayed or used.
  - F. Ask me before you leave the program.
  - G. Follow all school rules, directions, and classroom procedures stated in the student handbook.
- II. If a student chooses to break any of the above rules, the consequences are as follows:
  - A. 1<sup>st</sup> offense—Verbal warning
  - B. 2<sup>nd</sup> offense—Corrective discipline (e.g., assign new seat, suspension of break, writing assignment, detention, etc.)
  - C. 3<sup>rd</sup> offense—Referral to office, corrective discipline, and/ or suspension.
  - D. 4<sup>th</sup> offense—Adult students will be dismissed from class. Adult students must visit with a school administrator before they are admitted back into the Program.
- III. Severe clause: In case of serious misconduct that would endanger the physical wellbeing of students, staff, or equipment; or misconduct that should deviate from accepted moral conduct, steps in the plan above may be bypassed.
- IV. Positive consequences—as a result of my students adhering to behavior rules—are as follows:
  - A. Additional group activities
  - **B.** Special projects
  - C. Independent study time
