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Careertech Rules - From Terri Hollarn

Reminder about a change to Careertech rules that I mentioned at Summer Conference:

This change is effective for the 2017-18 school year. The new rules remove the requirement for a 10-month contract and revise the requirement for receiving the Careertech salary supplement and other program assistance. This change is in recognition of all the hard work you do for your students and the extra time you put in for Summer Conference, Teacher Academy, FCCLA activities, professional development, CTE reports, and all the other things that you do to maintain a quality FACS program. This is a big change that affects every FACS comprehensive school teacher. Make sure you read your local contract to determine if there are other factors that would require you to be there 10 months. If in doubt, ask your building administrator. Contact your program specialist or me if you have further questions.



Chromebook users can create 1 library per teacher for free and the library will hold 40 books. There is special pricing for teachers who need more than one library. There is also a Windows version for PC's where students can save a book to One Drive, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc. and then access it using a mobile device.
