Objective:

Students will understand the digestive system and construct from paper the alimentary canal with its associated structures.

Strategy:

Part I: Anatomy of the Digestive System

Draw the organs of digestion and the accessory organs. Color and cut them out then assemble them together on a poster large piece of poster board. Follow the alimentary canal from the mouth to the anus. (Note: Make sure to draw the organs to fit the poster board.)
