

# UNIT 12 - REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

## ACTIVITY - Wheel of life

### **Objective:**

The student will follow the life cycle from fertilization to death.

### **Materials:**

- Heavy paper
- Brass fastener (brad)
- Scissors
- markers

### **Strategy:**

Students will work individually.

Cut a circle from a heavy piece of paper. Cut a smaller circle from another piece of paper to cover the first circle but leave space at the top to write each one of the stages of life. Divide the large circle into eight pie shapes.

Each student will make a life wheel that includes all the stages of life. They will place information about each of the life stages on the wheel and then cut a cover with a wedge removed to be able to read the information underneath. Fasten the small circle to the center of the larger circle with the brass fastener. Label the cover, "The Stages of Life."

Include the following stages of life:

- Zygote
- Embryo
- Fetus
- Neonate
- Child
- Adolescent
- Adult
- Senescence
