

UNIT 12 - REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

CAREERS

OB/GYN (Therapeutic Services) - The OB/GYN is a medical doctor trained to diagnose, treat, and help prevent diseases of women, especially those affecting the reproductive system and the process of childbirth.

Community Health Specialist (Health Informatics) - These professionals promote, maintain, and improve individual and community health by assisting individuals and communities to adopt healthy behaviors. They collect and analyze data to identify community needs prior to planning, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating programs designed to encourage healthy lifestyles, policies, and environments. They also serve as a resource to assist individuals, other professionals, or the community, and may administer fiscal resources for health education programs.

Facility Manager (Support Services) - The facility manager will plan, direct, or coordinate medicine and health services in hospitals, clinics, managed care organizations, public health agencies, or similar organizations.

Mid Wife (Therapeutic Services) – The mid wife is an advanced practice nurse who specializes in the care of the mother and baby before, during, and after the birthing process. Mid wives may work under a physician in the office and the delivery room seeing and caring for patients.
