UNIT 4 - SKELETAL SYSTEM ACTIVITY - Bone Bingo (BONEO)

Objective:

This activity is used as a review of the bones of the skeletal system. Students are given the opportunity to show how much they have learned about the bones, bone markings and joints.

Materials:

Each student will need a sheet of blank paper and a pencil. They will also need a way to mark the boxes of their Boneo sheet. Small candies such as smarties or sweet tarts may be used.

Strategy:

Each student will fold their blank paper into a grid with five squares across the top and five squares along the side. (The teacher may make a computer bingo grid to pass out to the class.) Each student will choose names from the list of bones, markings, and joints listed in the state standards and objectives. The student will fill in the grid.

As the teacher shows or points to a bone part the student silently marks the BONEO grid with their marker. When the student has a marker up and down, across or diagonal they raise shout out "BONEO". The teacher then asks the student to read what is on their BONEO grid.

Play continues as the bones are described and reviewed by the teacher.
