UNIT 7 - ENDOCRINE SYSTEM CAREERS

Biostatistician (Biotechnology Research & Development)-The biostatistician engages in the development of mathematical theory or apply theory and methods to collect, organize, interpret, and summarize numerical data on biological topics to provide usable information

Pathologist (Therapeutic Services)- The pathologist is a physician who specializes in laboratory studies of cells and tissues to help other physicians make accurate diagnoses. One of the principal functions of a pathologist is to examine tissues for any changes that might indicate disease.

Advanced Practice Nurse (Therapeutic Services)- Includes advance practice nurses such as: nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists, certified nurse midwives, and certified registered nurse anesthetists. Advanced practice nursing is practiced by Registered Nurses who have specialized formal, post-basic education and who function in highly autonomous and specialized roles.

Clinical Lab Scientist (Diagnostic Services)- The clinical lab scientist examine and analyze body fluids, tissues, and cells. They look for bacteria, parasites, and other microorganisms; analyze the chemical contents of fluids; match blood for transfusions; and test for drug levels in blood to show how a patient is responding to treatment. They use automated equipment and instruments capable of performing a number of tests simultaneously, as well as microscopes, cell counters, and other sophisticated laboratory equipment. They analyze the data and relay the results to physicians.
