## Program Assistance Money for FY18

- \$5126 full-time funded programs
- \$2000 salary stipend for full-time programs
- \$2563 half-time funded programs
- \$1000 salary stipend for half-time funded programs

According to the CareerTech Rules book, the 412/314 program assistance . “...monies shall be used to support the additional costs of the CareerTech program limited to the purchase of equipment, instructional delivery and supplies, and staff development.” (staff development is only for the FACS teacher)

\$168.00 of 412/314 program assistance monies may be used toward FCCLA affiliation per chapter (not per program).

## New Wall Chart



CIMC has designed a new wall chart that can be ordered on-demand from the Printing Plant. It is a 24x36 laminated chart that can be used with a dry erase marker. The cost would be \$18.50 plus shipping.
