1. Overview of the Single Choice Set Content Type

The H5P Single-Choice-Set content type allows you to create question sets consisting of single-choice questions. Users receive feedback after submitting each answer.

IMPORTANT: Before creating any H5P element, turn on editing for your course site. Under the section or topic where the H5P element is to appear, click the **Add an activity** dropdown menu and choose **Interactive Content** from the list. Save your work periodically, and try out the features as you create them to help you understand how they function.

Note: See tutorial **0—General H5P Settings** for instructions on how to set up H5P activities for grades and other information.

2. Adding a New Single-Choice-Set Activity

The following steps walk you through the process of adding a Single Choice Set.

Step	Action	Notes
1.	In the Name field, type in a name for the H5P interaction.	For training purposes, type: Single Choice Set.
2.	In the Editor section, select Single Choice Set from the list of content types.	The Single Choice Set editor should appear.

Step	Action	Notes
3.	Type your question in the Question field of the first Question & alternatives block.	For training purposes, type: Which of the following statements is TRUE concerning the behavior of neonates?
4.	Type the correct answer in the first Alternative field.	For training purposes, type: The baby will turn his head toward anything his cheek touches.
5.	Type alternative answers in the remaining Alternative fields. Click on Add answer to add additional Alternative fields, if necessary.	 For training purposes, enter the following alternative answers: An infant begins walking during this stage. A typical neonate will breathe much more slowly than an adult.
6.	Type your second question in the Question field of the second Question & alternatives block.	For training purposes, type: Which of the following statements is FALSE concerning the human growth and development during the first year?
7.	Type the correct answer in the first Alternative field.	For training purposes, type: A baby will learn to control her legs before she learns to control her head.
8.	Type alternative answers in the remaining Alternative fields. Click on Add answer to add additional Alternative fields, if necessary.	 For training purposes, enter the following alternative answers: A baby will learn to sit before she learns to walk. Sight will improve to nearly that of adults by the age of 8 months.
9.	Click Save and display at the bottom of the screen when finished editing.	This step applies when using H5P content in Moodle server, such as ctYOU.org. Saving may be different in other applications.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to test all of the multimedia elements you created for this tutorial. Once completed, you can use this H5P feature as a standalone, embed its iframe code in a webpage, or you can download it for use in another courses.
