

Affiliation Tips & Tricks

Affiliation is now open on the national website! Oklahoma's first affiliation date is October 10th. Here are a few tips and tricks seasoned advisers use:

1) To get a separate invoice for the adviser dues only, click the submit button without checking the boxes next to the student names.

2) If using 412 funds for affiliation, select 12 students to affiliate. Submit the other students later.

3) Complete all red button tasks before you submit students for affiliation.

4) Graduate students first and then roll remaining students forward. This keeps you from inputting new grade levels for each member.
