Some teenagers are arranged on the public library's front steps for a photograph. Pablo is standing on the middle step, Greta is 5 steps above him, Amir is 2 steps below Greta, and Belinda is 9 steps above Amir. Belinda is also 6 steps from the top.

How many steps are there?

If Pablo's step number is P , then the top step is number $P + 5 - 2 + 9 + 6$, or $P + 18$. But Pablo's step is the middle step, so there are $18 + 1 + 18 = 37$ steps in all.
