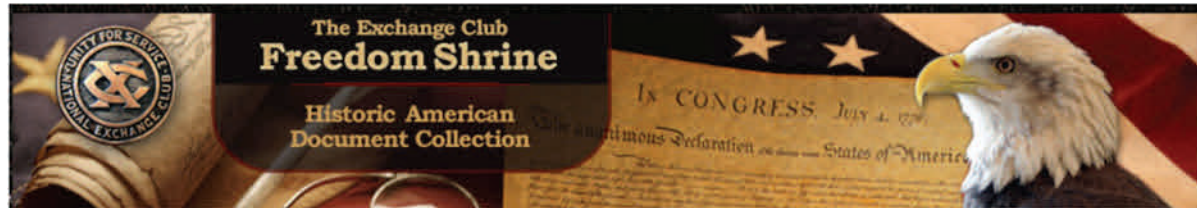

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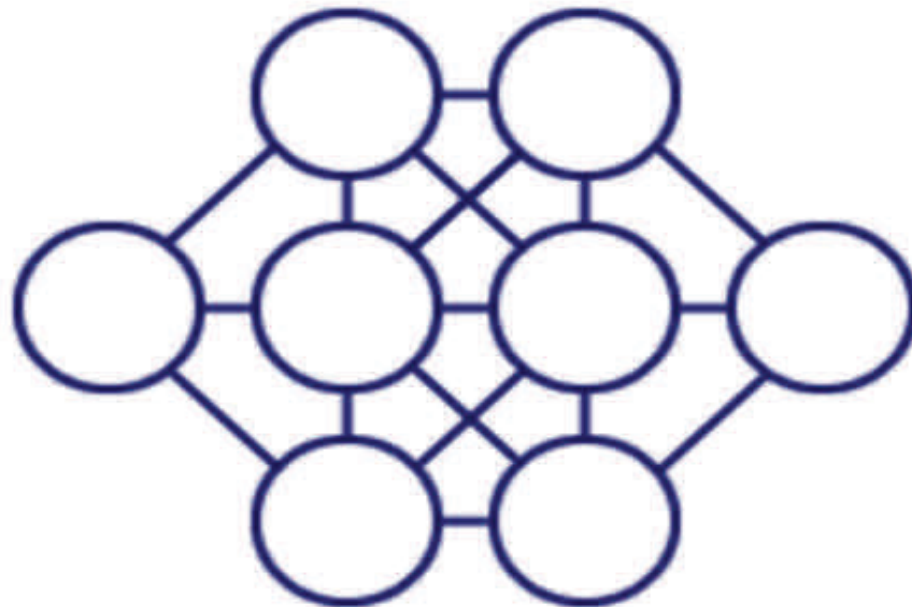

Can you place the numbers 1 to 8 into the following grid? No two consecutive numbers can be directly next to each other either vertically, horizontally, or diagonally.

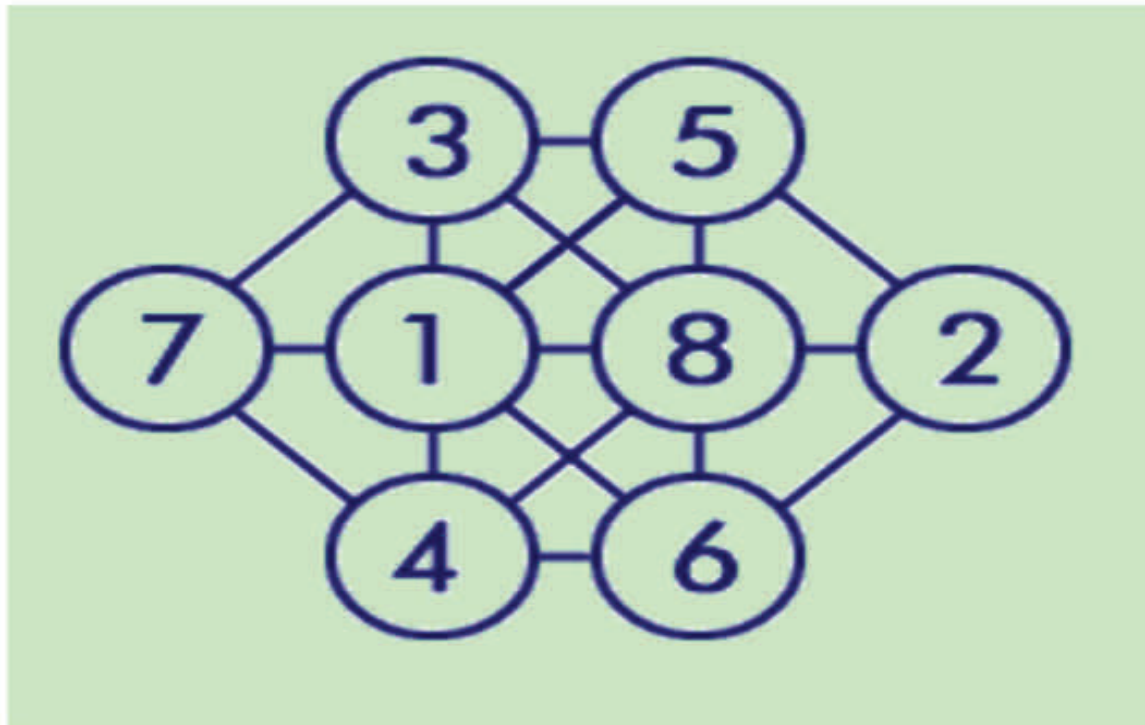




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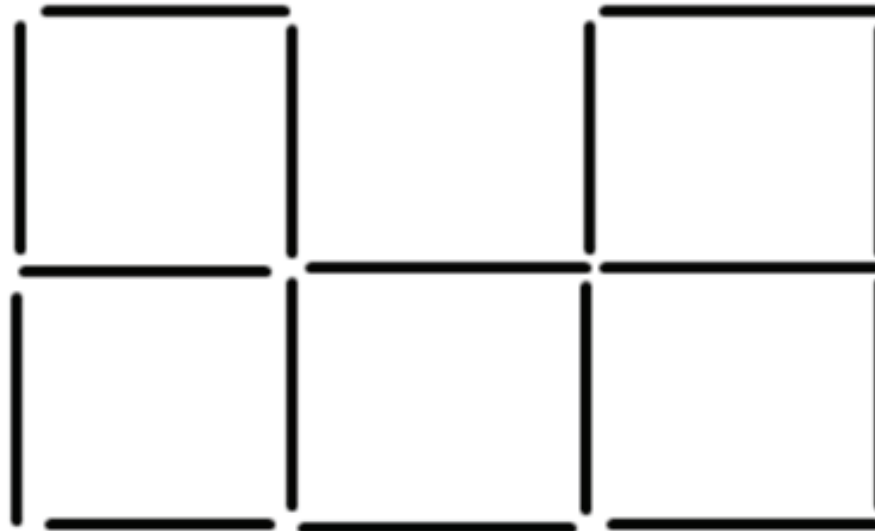

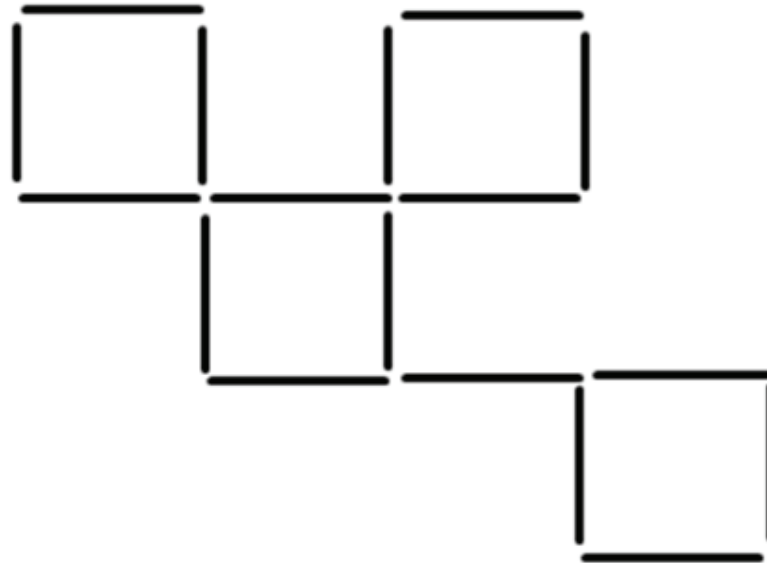

$$IX - XII = III$$

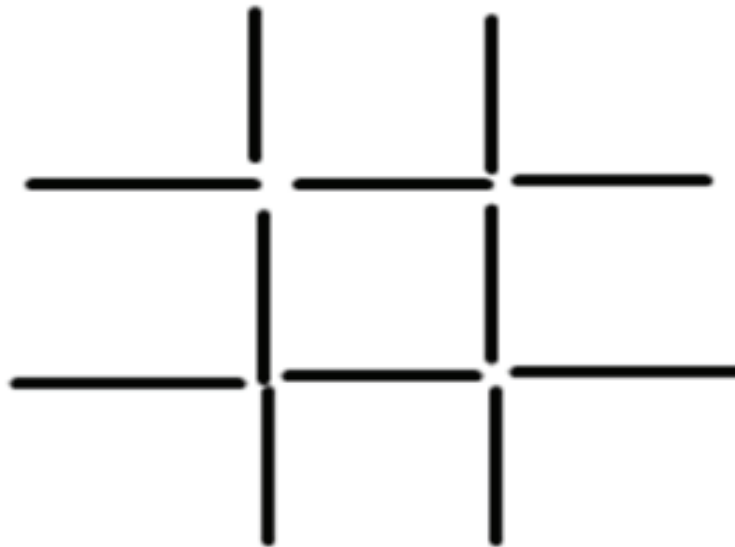
