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# What standards are used to develop FCS curriculum?

Yes, just like every other subject in schools across Oklahoma, FCS curriculum is governed by standards. These standards are in their third iteration, originally approved in 1994. They were updated again in 2005 and most recently in 2014. If you haven't read the revised standards, please carve out 10 minutes a day to read a few of the 15 standards until you get through them all. These, along with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills and Career Cluster skills, provide the framework for FCS in the United States.

The advisory board voted for a policy change to STAR Events. Beginning at the district level "All first place winners will advance from district to region contests. Second place winners who score an 80 or above will advance to the region competition as well." The policy further states "All first place winners will advance from region to state. Second place winners who score 80 or above will advance to state competition as well. All national contests first and second place winners who score 80 or above will advance from state to national competition."
