

Pre-Launch Lesson Plan

GRADE K, PLANET C | ORGANIZERS ARE NEAT

Objectives

- Students will understand what it means to be organized and how it relates to the conventional work environment.
- Students will explore how organizing things helps people work more efficiently.
- Students will practice organizing objects in a fun, hands-on way.

Preparation & Materials Needed

- Paper
- Crayons or markers
- Small containers or boxes
- Items to organize (books, blocks, etc.)

Lesson Plan

Total Time: 16-20 minutes

INTRODUCTION

5-7 Minutes

Tell students that today you're going to explore Planet C. On the Conventional planet, workers are called "organizers."

Write the word "organize" on the board.

Speak to the class:

- *What does it mean to organize something?*
- Let students share their thoughts. Explain that Organizers love keeping things in order. They like to make sure everything has its own place and follows the rules.
- *Today, we are going to learn how organizing things can help us do things faster and better, just like the people on Planet C.*
- *What are some things you like to organize at home?*
- *How does it feel when your toys or books are organized?*
- *Can you think of a job where being organized is really important?*
- *What happens when things are messy or unorganized?*



ACTIVITY

10-12 Minutes

Prompt for Class:

Let's practice being organizers like they do on Planet C! We're going to organize some things in our classroom, just like a warehouse worker does with boxes.

Instructions:

1. Provide small containers, boxes, or piles of objects (e.g., books, blocks, colored items).
2. Ask the students to organize the items based on a simple rule, such as by color, size, or type (e.g., all the red blocks together, all the books by their size).
3. Allow students to work together to sort the items in an organized way.
4. Discuss how organizing helped them complete the task.

Ask students:

- *How did you decide how to organize your items?*
- *Why is it helpful to organize things?*
- *How did organizing make the task easier?*
- *What would happen if everything was mixed up?*

CONCLUSION

1-2 Minutes

Remind the students that on Planet C, organizers make everything neat and orderly so they can do their work better and faster.

Now, let's explore the jobs people work on Planet C in Galaxy!
