



Planet R, The Realistic Planet

On Planet R, the realistic planet, students learn about job shadowing.

In the game for this planet, students shadow a landscape gardener, helping to place plants and landscape features according to a blueprint. The first activity for this planet is a job shadowing checklist that helps students understand what to expect and do before, during and after a job shadowing experience. The second activity asks students to reflect on how much they would like to do the kinds of tasks people with realistic interests and occupations do.

In the game at Level 3 on Planet A, students work as landscape architects to beautify a barren space. They use colored stones, plants and fountains to create a space that people can enjoy. The activity on this planet asks students how they feel experiencing and participating in many kinds of artistic and creative activities.

Here are suggestions for supporting your child's learning:

Ask: Would you like doing work with your hands and tools? What kinds of activities do you do now that use your hands or tools? (Examples might include baking, gardening, building model airplanes, flying a drone or making craft projects.) Do you enjoy reading and interpreting instructions like the blueprint in the game, instructions for building models, recipes or patterns? Would you like to go to a business or work site for a few hours and spend time watching someone who does a particular job? What kind of worker would you like to shadow?

Do: Take your child to work with you for few hours or even a whole day. Show your child where you work and what you do during your workday. Talk about your work and answer your child's questions.









