Salary and Teaching Schedules

The Salary and Teaching Schedule data collection is ready to complete for the 2019-2020 school year. If you previously created an account in CTIMS, you will use the same user name (school email address) and password that you created. If you have forgotten your password, there is a "Forgot your password?" link on the CTIMS log in screen. You have 5 attempts to guess your password. After that, you will be locked out of the system and will have to contact our office to set up your account again.

For those that have not created a CTIMS account, emails have been sent to schools earlier this week. If you have not received an email from CTIMS by Tuesday, September 5, please contact ctimssupport@careertech.ok.gov for a status on your account.

Remember to use Internet Explorer when using CTIMS. Other browsers are not guaranteed to capture and submit your data successfully.
