## Unit 12 - Kitchen Safety and Sanitation

## Crime Scene Kitchen

Set up kitchen with the following props/and scenes. Feel free to place additional props specific to your kitchen or rules.

- 1. Masking tape outline of person on the floor
- 2. Newspaper (with burnt edges) on the floor next to outline
- 3. Several cabinet doors open
- 4. Pan on the floor near the outline
- 5. Pan on the range top with handle pointing forward (off the front)
- 6. Metal bowl in microwave microwave door open
- 7. Knife on the floor with ketchup on it
- 8. Water on the floor by sink (option: use masking tape to outline a puddle label as water)
- 9. Oven door open with baking dish on the door, one oven mitt on floor
- 10. Dishwasher open with points of knives facing upward
- 11. Chair in the kitchen with overhead cabinet door open
- 12. Chemical spray bottle on range top
- 13. Clutter/trash on the floor
- 14. Towel on a burner
- 15. Huge knife on counter with an orange or apple
- 16. Drawers open
- 17. Electric cord near a sink
- 18. Half full glass of water near stove top
- 19. Black construction paper to indicate burnt spots on cabinets
- 20. Clutter on counters

Surround entire area with POLICE - DANGER - CRIME SCENE TAPE.

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**Assignment:** You and your team are the CSI (Crime Scene Investigators) on the scene. It is your job to decide what YOU THINK happened to the victim. Write a 100-word news story describing the results of your investigation. Your CREATIVE and DETAILED news story must include the following information:

- 1. Headline for the story
- 2. Name and age of the victim
- 3. Location of the residence (street, city, state), time and date of accident
- 4. A DETAILED description of your team's accident analysis (i.e. fire, explosion, poisoning, fall, etc.)
- 5. Cite four or more safety hazards that may have contributed to the accident
