Objectives:

FACS 1 Unit 17 Objectives:

1. Identify uses of personal living space.
2. Identify basic storage guidelines.
3. Identify questions to answer when evaluating a personal living space.
4. Select advantages of an orderly living space.

Materials needed:

Laptop with 3D Home Architect program.

Resources:

3D Home Architect computer program
FACS 1 CIMC textbook

Lesson Summary/Outline:

Each student will be required to design a personal living space using the 3D Home Architect program and classroom laptops.

Motivator/Opening:

Begin unit by showing interesting homes. You can use pictures of homes you have visited or from google images.

Activities:

1. Students will take pictures of their personal space and send them to instructor through email or text message.
2. Instructor will display pictures and class will try to determine which room belongs to which student based on personality and activities.

Assignments:

Create your personal living space using 3D Home Architect program on classroom laptops.

Design must include:

1. Walls
2. Interior door
3. Closet
4. Window
5. Furniture – bed, dresser or chest, night stand
6. Electrical outlet
7. Light fixtures
8. Optional: bathroom, colors,
9. Each item must be labeled.

Evaluation:

Designs are evaluated based on the following rubric components: required elements, labels, attractiveness, use of class time.

Notes:

I allow my students creative freedom in completing this assignment. They must include all of the assigned components but shape and selection of windows, doors, furniture styles, etc. is the students' choice.
