Standard Ruler


Standard rulers typically measure distances down $1 / 16$ of an inch, although some versions have marks down to $1 / 32$ or $1 / 64$ of an inch. Rulers are generally 6,12 , or 36 inches long.

 Metric RulerMetric rulers typically measure distances in centimeters and millimeters. Each centimeter is broken down into ten sections called millimeters.
