






#### Using a Standard Ruler

Standard rulers typically measure distances down 1/16 of an inch, although some versions have marks down to 1/32 or 1/64 of an inch. Rulers are generally 6, 12, or 36 inches long.







## Using a Metric Ruler

Metric rulers typically measure distances in centimeters and millimeters. Each centimeter is broken down into ten sections called millimeters.


#### **Commonly used for measuring:**
