## Farm to School Program offers School Garden Kits

Now through **March 1**, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry's Farm to School program is accepting applications for school garden kits on behalf of the USDA Specialty Crop Block Grant.

The primary aim of these school gardens is to not only promote healthy eating habits, but also educate students on where their food comes from and how to produce that food themselves.

The Farm to School program will partner with four public schools and three Early Childhood Centers to provide garden kits for the schools.

The kits will include everything needed to build, grow and maintain the garden.

Each school selected to participate in the twoyear program will receive a stipend for a garden coordinator.
