During this fall semester an exciting project is taking place that is designed to provide multiple resources for FCS teachers in Oklahoma. Several free "how-to-guides" will be made available from Oklahoma State University that focus on specific strategies for using technology to enhance instruction. Topics range from engagement activities to tools for both inperson and online classes.
