## FCCLA Meat Identification Competition – NEW

Oklahoma FCCLA, in partnership with Farm Bureau Women's Leadership Committee, is proud to announce the newest Oklahoma FCCLA competition: Meat Identification. This event, which will take place during State STAR Events, aligns with the iCEV Meat Selection and Cookery Certification curriculum. In addition to the test associated as part of the competition, Level 3 and 4 participants will also have the opportunity to take the American Meat Science Association certification test at no charge (regularly \$75 per person). They must make a 70% in order to receive the certification. Competition attire is listed in the rubric and is NOT chef or FCCLA attire, so please read carefully. This event is also an individual AND team event, in which individuals will receive first, second, and third place per level and overall teams will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
