K12 End-of-Course Test Collection

Information Management has opened a new collection module, the Certification System, for you to enter certifications and work-based learning opportunities in real time. You will now be able to add this information at any time throughout the year rather than waiting for follow-up to open. Once it is entered in the Certification System module, it will transfer over to the Follow-up module. For example, if you enter the certifications and work-based learning information for your current students, it will populate in follow-up for the next collection period. (But, please make sure you verify you are entering information in the correct enrollment year.)

SHL Testing Questions

We have heard from some of you about challenges with SHL TalentCentral testing. We want to let you know that we are working with them to find solutions.

Some of you have been asking about the accepted cut scores. If the test has a point score provided, the cut score would still be 2.75, as it has been in the past. If there is no point score provided, then you should use the percentile score -30^{th} percentile is the cut score. We will be working with SHL to determine if there is a more appropriate method for Oklahoma scores.

Keep in mind there are multiple testing options listed on each syllabus. Use the one that is best for your situation.
