CESI FAQs

Q: Who do I contact for my PID?

A: BMITE office 405.743.5119 or Pamela.Porter@careertech.ok.gov

Q: What if I get an error that I can't upload the excel template?

A: Contact CTIMSSupport@careertech.ok.gov 405.743.5134

Q: What are the most common errors when using the template?

A: Column K incorrect date format yyyyymmdd (long date format)

A: Needing 0 or 1 in columns L-AB

Q: Do I have to fill in all columns?

A: The columns marked “not required” do not need to be filled in (Columns E, G, H)

Q: Single Parent Column?

A: Is the student a single parent?

Q: What is my CTIMS username?

A: Your school email

Q: What is my CTIMS password?

A: Use the password you created for Salary and Teaching report

Q: What if I forgot my CTIMS password?

A: Click the “Forgot your password?” link on the CTIMS log in screen. You have 5 attempts to guess your password. After that, you will be locked out of the system and will have to contact CTIMS Support to set up your account again. It’s best to select the “Forgot your password?” before getting locked out of the system.

National Cybersecurity Teaching Academy

The National Cybersecurity Teaching Academy (NCTA), through a recent grant, will offer a 12-credit hour graduate certificate to high school teachers and include coursework on teaching cybersecurity, foundations of cybersecurity, network security, and advanced topics. Three universities (DePaul, University of Louisville, and UA Little Rock) will offer the virtual program, with a little variation depending on the university’s program.

Follow-up Timeline CHANGED!!

The collection period for follow-up has changed this year due to new federal requirements handed down to us with Carl Perkins funding. **Follow-up for the 2020-2021 school year will be accessible, in CTIMS, from October 1, 2021 – November 30, 2021.**

End-of-Course Test Reporting

We are collecting end-of instruction test results (Pass/Fail) for all students. You can add students' test results at any time throughout the year as long as the students have been entered into CESI. Once test data is entered into the Certification System module, it will transfer over to the Follow-up module. For example, certification results entered for *current* students will populate in follow-up for the next collection period. (NOTE: Verify you are entering information in the correct enrollment year.)

Which certification test results should be included? Any test listed as one of the required test options on the BMITE course syllabus or testing guide should be included if your student has taken that test.

You can find the **Technical Guidebook** for entering **Student Certifications & Work Based Learning Collection** on the CTIMS website (scroll towards the bottom of the page).
