All competitors must be finalized in STAR Events registration by **February 15<sup>th</sup>**. <u>Students who</u> <u>should have competed at Regional STAR Events were automatically advanced to State</u> <u>and they still need to be finalized in your registration portal</u>. If they are NOT competing, you have until **February 15<sup>th</sup>** to drop them and avoid paying a fee. If a student is competing in an event that should have started at the state level, they must be registered by **February 15<sup>th</sup>**. Students on invoices after **February 15<sup>th</sup>** must pay their competitive event fee.
