<u>NLC Intent to Compete Form –</u> You need to complete this form for **every event** you have qualified for NLC, whether they are going or not. If this is a team event, there are enough spaces to place all team names on that submission. <u>Please complete this by April 22nd.</u> You cannot register your competitors for their STAR Event on the NLC registration site until you complete this form and Brittani approves them. She will do this daily.
