Oklahoma FCCLA students win at National Conference

More than 150 Oklahoma FCCLA students competed in 91 events at the 77th FCCLA National Leadership Conference recently and brought home more than 50 contest honors, along with other awards.

Oklahoma Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, which had a delegation of 317 people, had 10 national champions, five runners-up and three third place finishers, along with 41 top 10 qualifiers.

In addition, the state chapter received an award for its membership increase. Oklahoma FCCLA broke its membership record this year with 14,700 members. State President Aubrey Phillips of Westville FCCLA accepted the membership increase award.

CareerTech awards \$4.5 million in Lottery Grants, Scholarships

The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education has awarded more than \$4.5 million in lottery funds.

CareerTech awarded \$2,064,816 in grants to 26 technology centers for the 2022-23 school year and \$2,056,516 in grants to K-12 school districts for the 2022-23 school year, along with 388 scholarships worth a total of \$400,150 for the 2021-22 school year.

"These funds from the Oklahoma Lottery will benefit instructors and students throughout the CareerTech system and help us fulfill our mission to give students the skills they need to enter the workforce and make informed career choices," said Lee Denney, CareerTech's interim state director. "Through the competitive grant process, there is a direct investment in classroom and training experiences, including new equipment, technology and enhanced instructional resources."
