- APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY September 15, 2022. Applications will be reviewed and notification will be made by September 22, 2022.
- Funds are awarded on a reimbursement basis to the school post cooking class.
 Activity must be completed prior to December 16, 2022.

Work-based learning video contest opens

Oklahoma CareerTech is accepting entries for a work-based learning video contest. The contest allows students in CareerTech work-based learning to show the benefits they receive. Students will write and produce their own videos and can win cash for their programs. The winning videos will be presented on Oklahoma CareerTech's website and YouTube channel.

Students can compete in two categories: high-end edited videos of 3 to 4 minutes and social media-type videos of 2 to 3 minutes. Six videos will be selected in each category; high-end winning videos will earn programs \$500, and social media-type winning videos will earn programs \$250.

Each program may submit up to five videos, and a single program can have up to three winning videos. The submission deadline is **Dec. 16**.
