EDUCATIONAL EXPLORATION

Learning Objective

Students will research occupations to identify the education they need to be successful at their chosen jobs.

Training Materials & Equipment

- A/V equipment for PowerPoint slides
- Computer/laptop for each student
- Lesson-Five.ppt
- OK Career Guide results sheets (should be in student files or folder)
- Exploring Training and Education Handout (one for each student)

Instructions



Ask students to pull out their OK Career Guide homework from the previous week.

Distribute the Exploring Training and Education worksheet. Review **(Slides 2-6)** the process to follow to fill out worksheet.

Students should transition to the computer lab or pick up a laptop for the next activity.

Explain that there are multiple ways to explore education. Students will use OKCareerGuide.org to look at schools based on occupations from assessment results. Then they will look at education through **Plan for Education** using a filter. During this, students will be gathering information on the worksheet.



Ask: Did you learn anything about the cost of education? Did the cost vary from one school to the next? Has the cost changed your mind about the occupation you chose?

Summary

All of the information researched today is going to be beneficial for students' educational growth and job searches. Although we cannot depend on the information to be 100% exact in all geographical areas, it is a good benchmark to go by when considering educational or occupational changes. Review the checklist so the students can see where they have been and where they are going next.
