

District STAR Event Registration Deadline October 26



Work-Based Learning Video Contest



Oklahoma CareerTech is accepting entries for a work-based learning video contest.

The contest allows students in CareerTech work-based learning to show the benefits they receive. Students will write and produce their own videos and can win cash for their programs. The winning videos will be presented on Oklahoma CareerTech's website and YouTube channel.

Students can compete in two categories: high-end edited videos of 3 to 4 minutes and social media-type videos of 2 to 3 minutes. Six videos will be selected in each category; high-end winning videos will earn programs \$500, and social media-type winning videos will earn programs \$250.

Each program may submit up to five videos, and a single program can have up to three winning videos. The submission deadline is **Dec. 16.**

Take a field trip! Particularly if you are on the far northeastern side of the state and teach Fashion Design.

Crystal Bridges Museum in Bentonville, AR is hosting *Fashioning America: Grit to Glamour.* it's first exhibition dedicated to fashion and the first to present American fashion as a powerful emblem of global visual culture, amplified by movies, television, red carpets, and social media. From dresses worn by first ladies to art-inspired garments to iconic fashion moments that defined a generation, the display includes over 100 garments and accessories selected from across two centuries of fashion.

For youth under 18, the exhibit is free; otherwise the cost is \$12.00. I recently toured the museum and they had a few of the garments already on display; I think it would be an awesome experience for students.

I would also recommend calling them and telling them you are bringing a student group. I know that Maxanne Kline at Bluejacket took her students there each year. (Yes, it is across state lines, so make sure that you get administration/board approval.)
