Department of Education's (Department) **Career Z Challenge**, a multi-phase prize competition to expand high school student access to highquality work-based learning (WBL) that will prepare them to be contributing members of today's workforce and propel them into successful careers of the future. This challenge supports the Biden-Harris



Administration's **Raise the Bar: Unlocking Career Success** initiative championed by the U.S. Departments of Education, Labor, and Commerce.

Through this Challenge, the Department invites Perkins eligible schools, districts, and consortiums to share their ideas for creating or enhancing WBL opportunities in career and technical education (CTE) programs through the expansion of WBL ecosystems. Eligible entrants will engage collaborative ecosystems of educators, businesses, industries, workforce


processionals, and community stakeholders to provide students interconnected and expansive career development opportunities and experiences across grades 9 - 12. Semi-finalists and finalists will be eligible to receive targeted technical assistance including professional development support, webinars and training, participation in a community of practice (CoP), as well as a portion of a \$2.5 million prize pool.

The lessons learned from this challenge will inform resources and models that will foster growth and expansion of high-quality, sustainable WBL experiences for students nationwide. I hope you will support the challenge in one or more of these ways:
