Oklahoma FCCLA Brings Home National Officer, Top 10 Honors

Oklahoma FCCLA took 347 people to the 78th FCCLA National Leadership Conference in Denver, Colorado, and brought home **46 top 10 contest honors and a national officer**. Olivia Boeckman, a Family, Career and Community Leaders of America member at Drummond High School, was elected the national vice president of community service during the conference.

Among the 46 top 10 finishes were **seven first places, five second places and seven third places**. The Oklahoma students were among 4,300 students from across the country who competed, attended workshops and speaker sessions and networked with other FCCLA members.

Oklahoma FCCLA also received an award for an increase in its membership. The state chapter has 17,356 members, the most since 1977.

"I am incredibly proud of our Oklahoma FCCLA members. We had a fantastic week and all of the hard work and preparation it takes to attend National Leadership Conference paid off. It is

always a great day to be an Oklahoma FCCLA member!" said Brittani Phillips, Oklahoma FCCLA state adviser.
