

Distinguished Service Award Presentation

Individuals whose primary responsibilities are directly related to FCCLA and who have uniquely contributed to the organization over and above normal job responsibilities may be awarded the Distinguished Service Award.

The Distinguished Service Award may be conferred at the local, district/region, state, and national levels according to criteria developed at each level. Usually, the conferring officers are the president and secretary.

President: "The Distinguished Service Award recognizes those persons whose primary responsibilities are directly related to the organization and who have made significant and valued contributions to the growth and progress of FCCLA." President explains why the award recipient has been selected. "It is with great pleasure we present the award to (name, title). Will you please step forward?"

Secretary: "(Name), I am pleased to present you with this (plaque, certificate, pin, etc.) in gratitude for prior and continuing service to Family, Career and Community Leaders of America."

Secretary steps back and recipient makes brief remarks.
