Lost Name Badges/Lanyards at State Convention

In order to provide a safe environment, FCCLA will have security checking for State Convention name badges/lanyards at each general session. A convention name badges/lanyard is required for entrance into the General Session and Exhibit Area. There will be a \$10 fee to replace a lost name badge/lanyard on the day of Convention. The person replacing their name badge/lanyard must have been previously registered with a chapter in order to receive a replacement.




