TASK 1


Supplies Needed:

1. Task 1 Secret Message Sheet
2. Scratch Paper
3. iPad

Directions:

1. Work as a group to decode the message.
 2. Each symbol stands for a letter.
- Hint:  = bomb = the letter B
3. Once you have done this, post your message on the wall and enter the code in to the Google Form in the link provided.

TASK 4

Supplies Needed:

1. Ziploc bag with symbol cards
2. Teamwork poem

Directions:

1. Sort each symbol into its own like group.
2. Each symbol represents a word in the poem titled "Teamwork." Figure out what each symbol represents. *Hint: 1 symbol represents and will not be used.*
3. Once you have done this, write the words in order as they appear in the poem.
4. Next, count the number of each symbol and write those numbers in the poem.

Teacher Setup Instructions:

- 1) Divide your students in groups of 3-4 students.
- 2) At each group, have a supplies container. The order of the supplies in the container does not matter. Have the following supplies in each container:
 - 1) Task Direction Pages (page 4, 6, 8, and 9)
 - 2) Task 1 Secret Message Page (page 5)
 - 3) Task 2 Word Cards – Printed on Cardstock, cut, and in a Ziploc bag (page 7)
 - 4) Task 4 Symbol Cards – Printed on cardstock, cut, and in a Ziploc bag (page 10)
 - 5) Task 4 “Teamwork” poem (page 11)
 - 6) *Optional* – Team Signs (pages 17-26)
 - 7) Scratch Paper
 - 8) 1 type of technology (iPad, laptop, tablet, etc.)
- 3) Have a way for your students to access the google form. I put the link in Google Classroom, but you could also write the link on your board.

How to Play

- 1) Follow Setup Instructions on page 2 first.
- 2) Go over the tasks directions with your students using the tasks directions pages.
- 3) Give instructions for how to access the Google Form (link on board or through Google Classroom –however you've decided to do it). Explain to students that they must complete the 4 tasks in order.
- 4) Google form will ONLY allow the correct answer, so if the student is unable to move on then they know they have the wrong answer and must redo that task to correct their error. Once the student has the correct code for ALL stations, the Google Form will say they have escaped. They must show you the screen that says they have escaped to prove they have escaped.

Directions:

1. Work as a group to decipher the message.
2. Each symbol stands for a letter.


Hint:  = bomb = the letter "b"

Some symbols might have double meanings, but it's your job to determine what the intended meaning is.

3. Once you have done this, enter the message into the Google Form in all lowercase.

1. Work as a group to alphabetize the words on the cards.
2. Once you have done this, take the numbers from the 7th, 11th, 20th, and 22nd cards to create the secret code.
3. Next, enter the code into the Google Form with no spaces.

3. Once you have done this, answer the 3 questions in the puzzle to discover your secret code.
4. Next, enter the code into the Google Form with no spaces.

TASK 4


Supplies Needed:

1. Ziploc bag with symbol cards
2. Teamwork poem
3. Technology

Directions:

1. Sort each symbol into its own group.
2. Each symbol represents a word in the poem titled "Teamwork." Figure out what word each symbol represents.
Hint: 1 symbol does not have a word in the poem that it represents and will not be used.
3. Once you have done this, put your stacks of symbols in order as the words they represent appear in the poem.
4. Next, count the number cards for each symbol and those numbers will be your codes in the order the words appear in the poem.




