# 8 Steps to Action (Making a Motion)

#### A member...

- Rise and ask for permission to speak
- Waits for permission to speak

#### Another member...

• Seconds the motion, "I second"

#### Chair...

- State the motion by saying, "It has been moved and seconded that\_\_\_\_"
- Calls for discussion
- Takes the vote
- State the result
