


Bring FCCLA to Life in the FCS Classroom

Every student who sits in my classroom is considered a FCCLA member, therefore if we do it in class it is not optional. I explain my classes are intra-curricular not extracurricular. So when we do FCCLA in class it is for a grade and everyone must participate.


If they want to compete or attend any meetings that do not take place in their FCS Class they must pay the chapter dues set at the beginning of the year.

Differences between Skills Demonstaration Events and STAR Events are that Skills Events take a lot less time to complete and are not as extensive.

The more you can play off of things already doing by bringing in more FCCLA activities the easier it is for you. For example you may do Interview Skills (skills demonstration event) in your careers unit and then turn that into a larger project like Job Interview.

Planning Process

This is used in every aspect of FCCLA and can be a tool that is used in classes for any project you do. Very similar to if you teach decision making processes use the planning process instead. You can utilize this for any and every project in class where students have to do any sort of planning.



Introduce FCCLA

1st 2 weeks of school use as an Intro to FCCLA creed, opening and closing ceremonies stations for introducing different events



Pick a STAR Event or Events for each day or create stations out of several events for the students to work through. This will give a small introduction to what events are and how they work.

I always print the STAR Event Manual and put in a binder for students to look through. I also put STAR Event names on pieces of paper that start at the District Level and let kids sign up for which ones they are most interested in

Sample plan for 1st 10 days

Day 1: What is FCCLA?

Day 2: Repurpose and Redesign

Day 3: Cake Decorating

Day 4: Creed/Opening and Closing ceremony

Day 5: Impromptu Speaking

Day 6: FCCLA Trivia (Skills Demo Event)

Day 7: Creed blackout Poetry

Day 8: Parliamentary Procedure

Day 9: Planning Process

Day 10: Recite the Creed



Station 1: Creed line mix-up or blackout poetry

Station 2: Cake decorating

Station 3: Repurpose and Redesign

Station 4: Toys that Teach


Station 5: FCCLA Trivia


Station 6: Impromptu Speaking

Culinary Food Art - Great for any culinary courses use when covering garnishing, could use when talking about knife skills, as a fun project

Culinary Knife Skills - All culinary units


Impromptu Speaking - any class where you cover a unit on communication or careers

Fashion Sketch - Use it in any fashion classes



Pastry Arts Technical Decorating Skills - could be used as a fun element in any culinary class or child development, hospitality and tourism

Speak out for FCCLA - This is part of the Power of One National Program. Use in any class where you are covering FCCLA. This could also be used as a promotional tool for your chapter recruitment.





Every course that we teach as an FCS Educator we can tie into a STAR Event and/or a National Program. Look for easy ways to incorporate the programs with things you are already doing.

Mental Health? Use Student Body or Families
First units that focus on mental health.

Community Service National Program - We all do community service projects already so that is an easy one. Are you teaching Fashion have your students plan a project where they are making something to benefit someone else. Example: last year my Fashion class made dog blankets for an organization that trains therapy dogs.


Career Connection - Do you teach careers? Do you do a career fair or bring in guest speakers? Maybe you can have your careers class create a career fair for elementary?
