

Duties of a District Officer

1. Attend DOT camp the 2nd week in June in Anadarko for 2 days. All the District officers from every chapter are required to attend. The counselors from your district go too.
 - *Meet all their district officers and other officers from the rest of the state
 - *Meet the state officers
 - * Plan their district's LEAD conference and District conference
2. On stage with a speaking part at LEAD conference and helps with the workshops for all members
3. Plan, organize, decorate and lead their district conference
4. Go to STAR events, district and region, to help run an event even if they're not participating
5. Can choose to go to the State STAR event and be a time keeper
6. Recognized on stage at the State Conference as a District Officer

District officer applications are usually due toward the end of April. They fill out a google form as their application. You need to know how involved you've been in FCCCLA. For example when or if you competed in a STAR event, how long you've been a member, any of the other conferences or FCCCLA events they've attended. Chapter and personal or school committees or community service the candidate may be involved in.

Record a 1 minute speech and upload it to the application website. The speech is something she wrote and memorized, and we practiced in official dress at school until she got it down.

Then during officer interviews, she is by herself, and recites her speech again. Then each judge asks one question. It only lasts about 5 minutes.
