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# **FCCLA State Convention**

**State Convention Information Packet** - this packet has all the information you need to make your State Convention experience a great one! Please refer to this document when registering and preparing for State Convention.

#### NEW THIS YEAR — Competitive Events Session Registration for State Convention

Parents, school admin, or guests that only want to attend the Competitive Events recognition session may purchase special entry for this session only. Cost is \$15 to attend. Participants must pickup their name badges at the registration table outside of the session room and may do so starting at 11:00 a.m. on the day of the convention. FCCLA Advisers are expected to register for the full registration rate, as this is only for one session.

**National Anthem Singer** - We're searching for a powerhouse musician to kick off the 2025 OK FCCLA State Convention with a breathtaking performance of the national anthem. Whether you're a singer, instrumentalist, or a combination of both, this is your chance to showcase your skills and inspire your fellow attendees. If you're a student with exceptional talent and stage presence, submit a video of your performance from the link below.

Submit your application by March 1st, 2025 and let your music resonate!

**50%. 75%, or 100% FCS Participation –** This award recognizes FCS programs with 50%, 75%,

or 100% of their FCS enrollment affiliated FCCLA members. Chapters will be recognized in the Closing Session of State Convention.

**Chapter of Excellence** -- The purpose of the Chapter of Excellence is to recognize FCCLA chapters that have excelled in the five components of FCCLA: membership, adviser, leadership, meetings, and projects. These are chapters that have well rounded programs and are active on the local, district, state, and national level.

FCCLA Chapters receiving **20 – 29.9** points will receive a Bronze Chapter of Excellence from Oklahoma FCCLA.

Chapters receiving **30 – 39.9** points will receive a Silver Chapter of Excellence award from Oklahoma FCCLA.

Chapters receiving **40** points or more will receive the Gold Chapter of Excellence Award from Oklahoma FCCLA.

All Chapters of Excellence award winners will be recognized on state during the annual

Oklahoma FCCLA State Convention.

This report is to be submitted via Google Form on the Oklahoma FCCLA website by **March 1, 2025.** This due date includes all FCCLA activities from **March 1, 2023 – March 1, 2025.** 

**Donna Kates Scholarship** -- The goal of the Donna Kates Scholarship is to provide financial aid to an FCCLA member from the Southeast Region who is attending the National FCCLA Leadership Meeting. The \$500 award will be disbursed to the student after he or she attends the National Leadership Conference and fulfills all of his or her responsibilities at the meeting.

**Grant-A-Wish FCCLA Chapter Grant** -- This is a grant given to the chapter adviser for items such as camper registration, FCCLA jackets, or a project. Chapters may submit a grant requesting items or registration waivers to help enhance their members' FCCLA experience. No ask is too big! Chapters must be present at the end of Convention to receive the Grant.

# Integration of FCCLA Award – Lee & Nevaleen Selmat Scholarship -- This award is made

possible with funds from the Lee & Nevaleen Selmat Endowed Scholarship. This scholarship is for a current FCS teacher when they show how they integrate FCCLA into their FCS curriculum. The \$500 award will be presented to a current Family and Consumer Sciences teacher to use on classroom supplies.

# Oklahoma Alumni & Associate Student Scholarship/Heather Hickman Memorial

**Scholarship** -- The Oklahoma Alumni & Associates student scholarship was established to provide financial aid to academically promising FCCLA members who will be pursuing post-secondary education. The award of \$1,500 will be disbursed to the institution once full-time status is verified. One \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating FCCLA member and one \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating State Officer.

Wanda Holman Scholarship -- The Wanda S. Holman Memorial Adviser Scholarship was

established in memory of Wanda Sue Holman, a member of the Oklahoma Alumni & Associates.

Wanda attended several national FCCLA conferences, and she believed that all advisers would benefit from such experiences. The \$750 scholarship is designed to offset the cost of attending the FCCLA National Leadership Conference. It will be awarded to a current

Oklahoma FCCLA Adviser who exhibits outstanding leadership and community service involvement.

Adviser Mentor Award -- The Adviser Mentor award recognizes the skills of experienced advisers who help orient and train new advisers. It also recognizes advisers who have been successful in--Achieving Master Adviser recognition; Devoting two years to new adviser assistance; Assuming adult leadership roles in Family, Career and Community Leaders of America; Conducting adviser workshops; Attending training workshops; Using national and state FCCLA resources. Applications must be completed in your FCCLA portal.

National Educated Adviser Award Application -- Applicants will be recognized for their

accomplishment of Adviser Professional Development hours. Evaluation will be based on the

following: Active affiliated FCCLA chapter, Professional Development Hours included on the

application must have been completed between April 1, 2022, and March 1, 2023. Minimum of 5

CEUs or 50 credit hours/units (10 PDU's = 1 CEU). 3 (at minimum) of which must be from FCCLA specific events. Applications must be completed in your FCCLA portal.

**Spirit of Advising Award** -- State Advisers should consider the following qualities in advisers when making their nomination: believes in the mission of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, supports and works with students to ensure student success, provides learning experiences, encourages positive character development, dedicates time and energy to nurturing student leaders Serves as a current FCCLA adviser. Award winners will be notified prior to State Convention. If you would like to nominate someone for this award, please email Brittani Phillips by March 1, 2025.

**Joann Carter Scholarship** - The goal of the Joann Carter Scholarship is to provide financial aid to an FCCLA member from the South Region who is attending the National FCCLA Leadership Meeting. The \$500 award will be disbursed to the student after he or she attends the National Leadership Conference and fulfills all of his or her responsibilities at the meeting.




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
