



Candidate Resumes and Voting Session

The State Officer Candidate resumes and videos, along with the Voting Delegate total per chapter are now on the Oklahoma FCCLA website. Chapters should host a meeting prior to State Convention, review the resumes and videos, and determine who they will vote for. Voting Delegates must be in official dress to cast ballots. One delegate may not cast all the votes for the chapter. Example- if your chapter has 4 delegates, you need 4 students to get all 4 votes.

Chapters should select a presidential candidate, two national officer candidates, five at large candidates, and one post-secondary representative.
