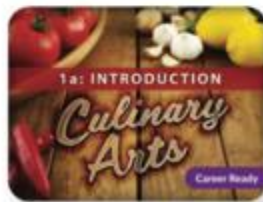

Horatio Alger Scholarship

National Career & Technical Scholarship

Award Amount: 300 scholarships at \$2,500 each

Eligibility Requirements:

- Have completed high school (or equivalency) by July 1
- Plan to attend a not-for-profit community college or trade/vocational school
- Enroll in an associate's degree, certificate, or diploma program by September that will lead to employment
- May not be enrolled in pre-requisite courses
- Demonstrate financial need (applicants must show household income of \$65,000 or less)
- Be under the age of 35
- Be a United States citizen
