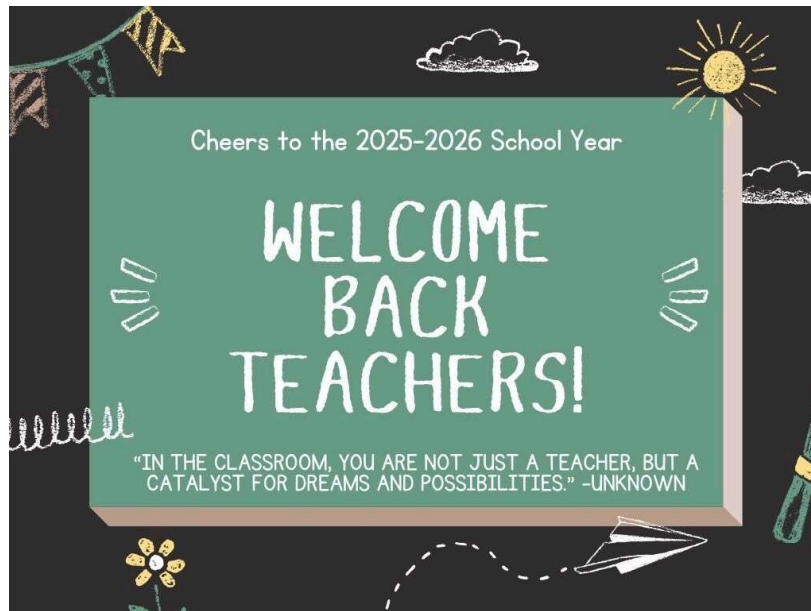

BUILDING BLOCKS FOR BETTER RELATIONSHIPS

Building Blocks For Better Relationships

Oklahoma Family and Consumer Sciences is once again partnering with The Dibble Institute through a contract awarded by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services to offer the Building Blocks for Better Relationships (BBBR) program. This curriculum, specifically designed for Oklahoma FCS classrooms, helps students build resiliency and develop stronger communication skills to support healthy, lasting relationships.

REQUIREMENTS

- Incorporate the BBBR curriculum (12 lessons) into class during 24/25 school year
- Teacher and student pre-assessment by deadline
- Teacher and student post-assessment by deadline

REIMBURSEMENT

- Lodging: \$125 for one night
- Per Diem: \$59 per day LESS meal provided
- Mileage: rate of .56 per mile, up to 200 miles
- \$200 for attending training (if new to BBBR)
- \$100 if re-upping (2nd year teaching BBBR)
- \$150 for pre-assessment completion
- \$150 for post-assessment completion
- \$100 if taught 3+ courses a day
