Invest in Your Future: Apply for the Lottery Funds Scholarship by Sept. 16

Oklahoma CareerTech educators, your path to professional growth just got easier! Thanks to the **Oklahoma Education Lottery Trust Fund**, scholarship dollars are now available to help you earn your teaching credentials—or even pursue administrator credentials if funds allow.

Here's what you need to know:

- **Courses:** Fall 2025 semester only
- **Deadline:** **September 16, 2025**
- **Eligibility:** Oklahoma residents enrolled in an accredited Oklahoma college or university with a **minimum 2.5 GPA** (or new students without GPA).

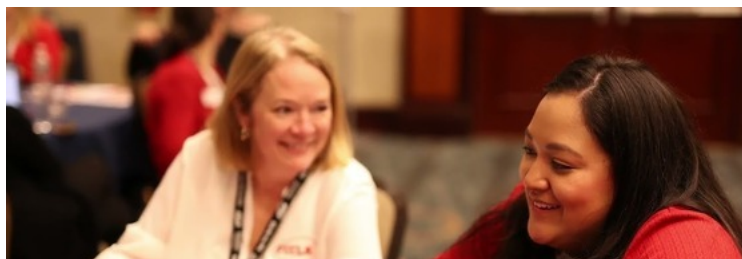
You may qualify if you are:

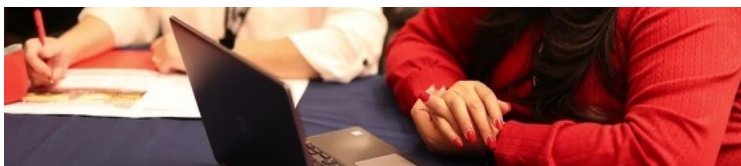
- **Full-time CareerTech teacher of an approved CareerTech program** working toward earning teacher certification or a degree in one of the following categories:
 - Provisionally certified teacher working toward a degree to meet their provisional certification requirements
 - Alternatively certified teacher taking the required 6-18 college credit hours
 - Certified instructor working toward a degree required by third party accrediting body (for example, Health instructor completing degree to satisfy COARC certification requirements)
- **Oklahoma Department of Career Tech Skills Center teacher** working toward a teaching credential in a CareerTech-related field.
- **Full-time CareerTech system employee** (i.e. teacher, instructional leader, or supervisor of CareerTech programs) seeking Technology Center Administrator Credential via Secondary Principal or Superintendent Certification. Counselors are not eligible for this scholarship.

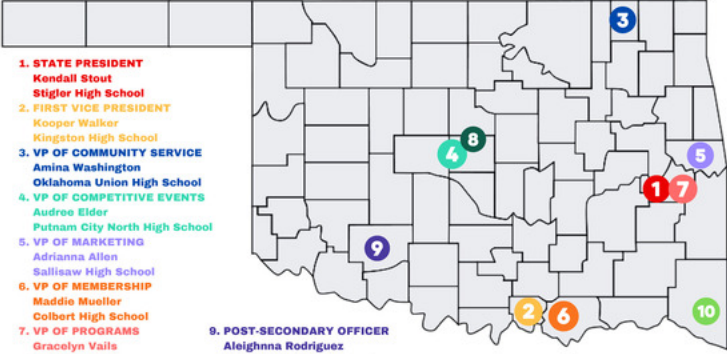
Request a State Officer

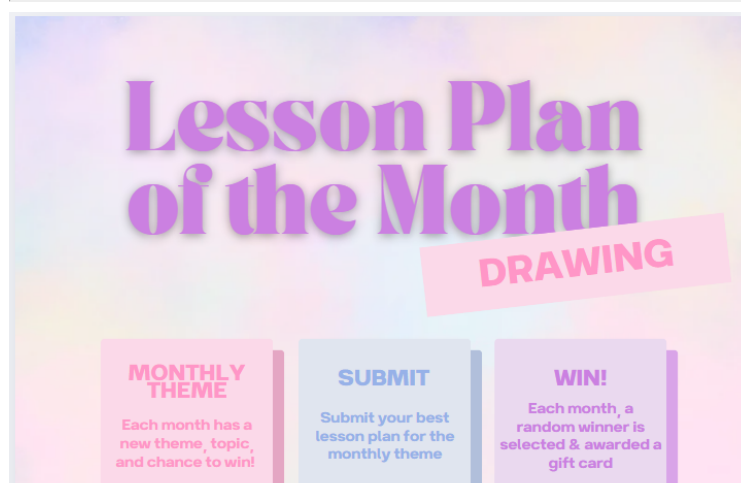

- ☐ **AS SOON AS PURCHASES ARE RECEIVED COMPLETE THE EQUIPMENT REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST**
 - Attach copies of all paid invoices and a detailed 469 expenditure report

Check before you submit!
