



Registering Split-Level Teams for Region STAR Events

If you are registering a team that has students in different levels, such as a level 2 and level 3 student, you must email brittani.phillips@careertech.ok.gov in order to get the team registered. You will see a message beside the event on the registration site that says, *"If you are trying to register teams with students in different levels, such as a Level 1 student with a Level 3 student, please email with the event name, names of students, and your region/district to [brittani.phillips@careertech.ok.gov"](mailto:brittani.phillips@careertech.ok.gov)"*

If you do not follow this process, the system does not catch this and enters them as separate competitors. If this happens and you have not emailed to correct, accommodations will not be made on Region STAR Event Day.



December Lesson Plan Challenge: “Threads of Tradition”



The holiday season is a time rich with **family traditions, seasonal celebrations, and creative expression**. For this month's challenge, we invite you to share lesson plans that **celebrate heritage, culture, and the artistry behind family traditions**—all while connecting to the **Fashion and Interior Design** pathways.

This theme encourages students to explore how **design and tradition** come together to create meaningful spaces, garments, and decor that reflect personal and cultural stories.

Lesson Plan Ideas:

- “**Deck the Halls with Design**” – Interior Design students create festive room layouts or decor boards that reflect seasonal celebrations and family gatherings.
- “**Table Traditions**” – Explore tablescape, place settings, or seasonal decor tied to family holiday meals.
- “**Heritage in Fashion**” – Students analyze traditional garments from different cultures and reinterpret them with modern design elements.
- “**Story Through Space**” – Students design an interior space that reflects a cherished family tradition or cultural celebration.

- “**Sewing Stories**” – Fashion students construct a simple garment, accessory, or decor item (e.g., stockings, tree skirts, embroidered napkins) that honors a personal or cultural holiday.

How to Participate:

- Lessons can be focused on **cultural celebrations, family rituals, or holiday-inspired design projects**.
