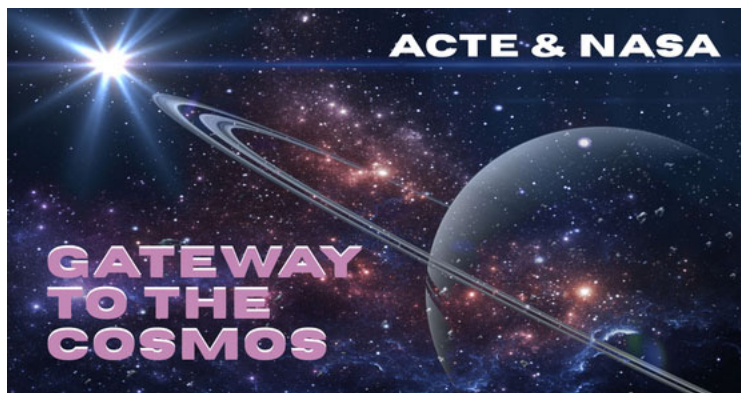

An orientation video for students and evaluators will be available on the state website and strongly encouraged for all participants to view.

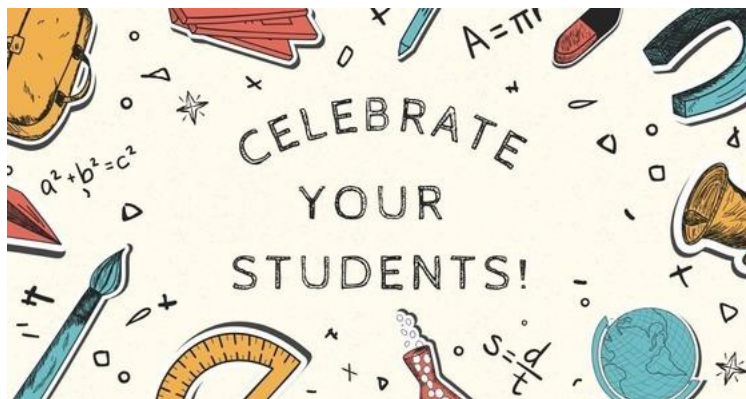
