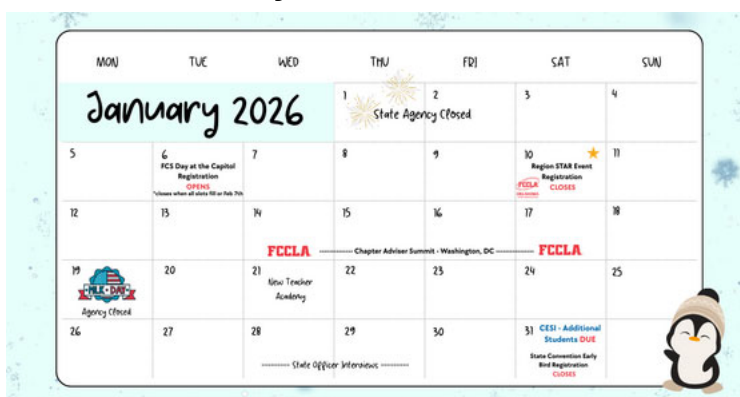

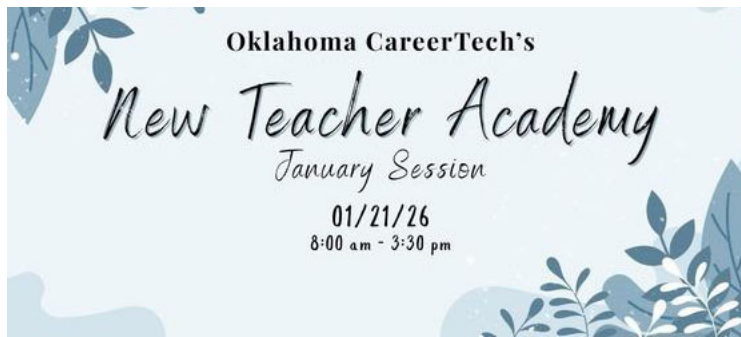

FCCLA State STAR Events Schedule Posted

The State STAR Events schedule is now posted on the Oklahoma FCCLA website. This schedule will let you know which event is taking place on March 25 or 26 and if it is in the morning or afternoon. If you do not have competitors competing at State STAR events, you do not attend. Competitors only need to be there for the registration of their event session. Example - if your competitor isn't competing until the afternoon

session, they will need to arrive for the afternoon session and not the morning.

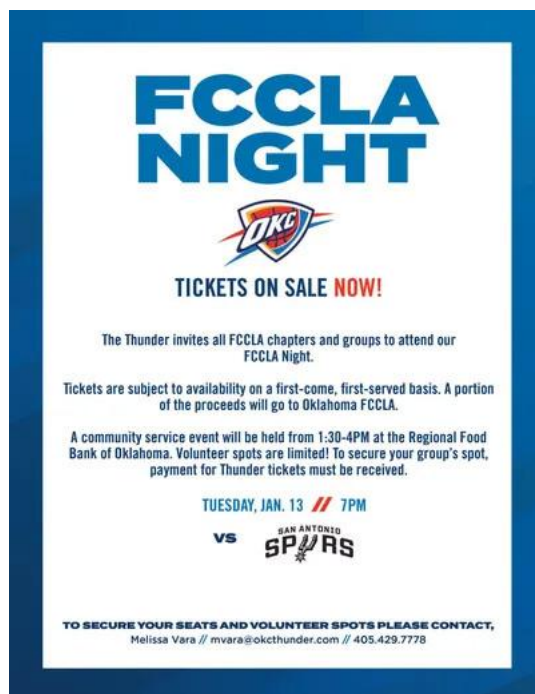

Registering Split-Level Teams for Region STAR Events

If you are registering a team that has students in different levels, such as a level 2 and level 3 student, you must email brittani.phillips@careertech.ok.gov in order to get the team registered. You will see a message beside the event on the registration site that says, *"If you are trying to register teams with students in different levels, such as a Level 1 student with a Level 3 student, please email with the event name, names of students, and your region/district to brittani.phillips@careertech.ok.gov"*

If you do not follow this process, the system does not catch this and enters them as separate competitors. If this happens and you have not emailed to correct, accommodations **will not** be made on Region STAR Event Day.

Parliamentary Procedure Testing Window January 20-23, 2026

Teams participating in the Parliamentary Procedure Event must take the Parli Test during the Oklahoma FCCLA testing window. This window is January 20-23, 2026. **Make plans now to secure a testing location and proctor, as all competitors from one school must test at the same time.** There will be no exceptions/extensions granted for this testing window, so do not plan to test at the last minute.

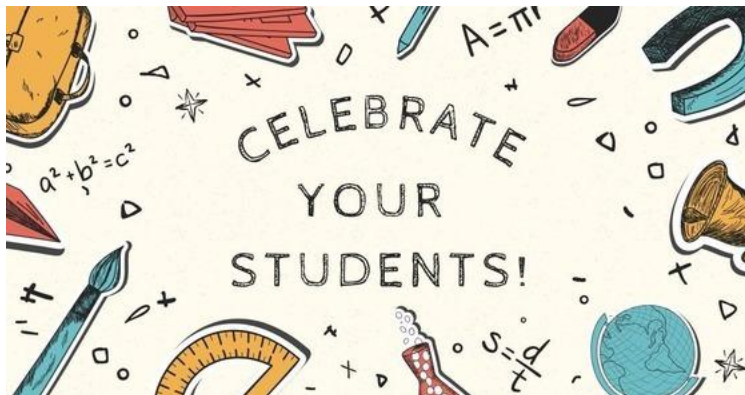
An orientation video for students and evaluators will be available on the state website and strongly encouraged for all participants to view.
