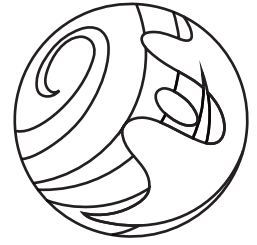

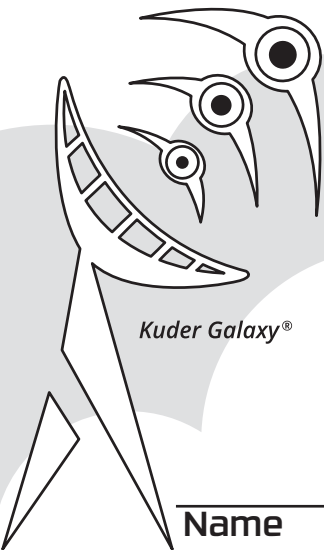

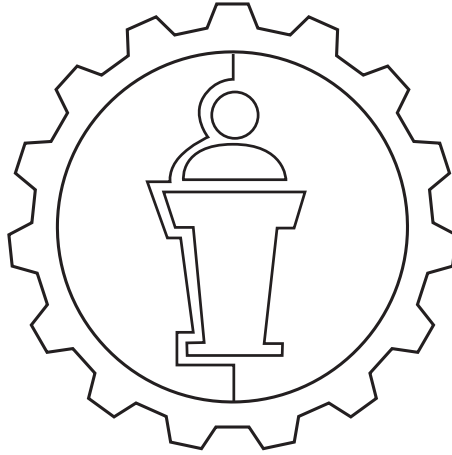

## Planet E, The Enterprising Planet

On Planet E, the enterprising planet, students discover that one way to learn about occupations is to take on a leadership role such as organizing a fundraiser or running for a class officer position.

In the game for this planet, students become the leader for a space colony that needs help. They meet the other people on the planet and figure out how to convince everyone to work together. The first activity for this planet focuses on what qualities make a good leader. The second activity asks students to reflect on how much they would like to do the kinds of tasks people with enterprising interests and occupations do.

Here are suggestions for supporting your child's learning:

**Ask:** Who do we know that is very persuasive? What makes them so convincing? What do they do or how do they act? Would you like to organize a group project or team? Can you imagine yourself starting your own business? What steps would you need to take to do that?

**Do:** As you go about your daily activities with your child, talk about the people you see who are leaders or supervisors or business owners. What do they have in common? Encourage your child to take on a leadership role at school or in a group. This could be a longer commitment like a class or club officer, or it might be a one-time commitment such as organizing and running a fundraiser.

### Questions

The following questions list things that may be good or bad for leaders to do. Answer yes if it is something a good leader does and no if it is not.
