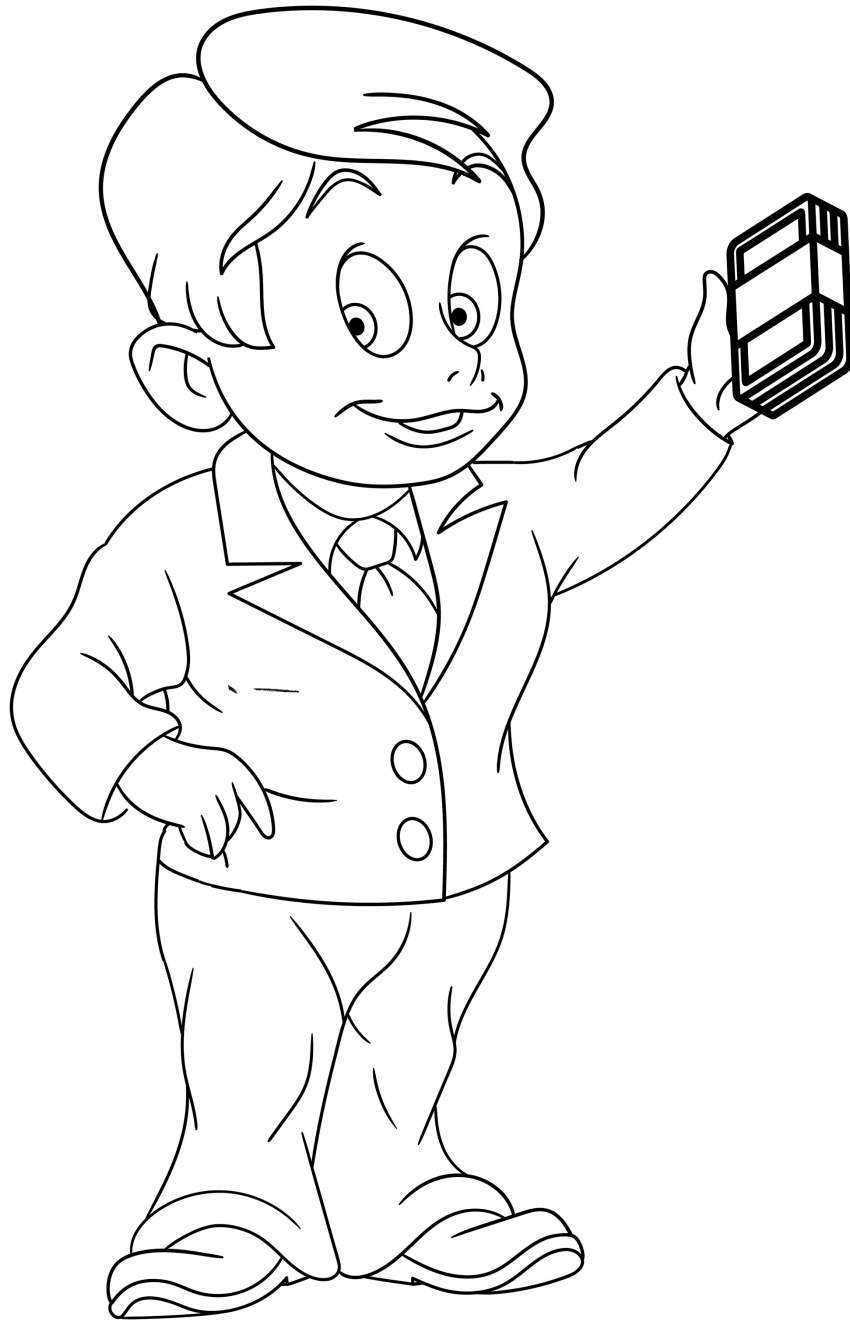

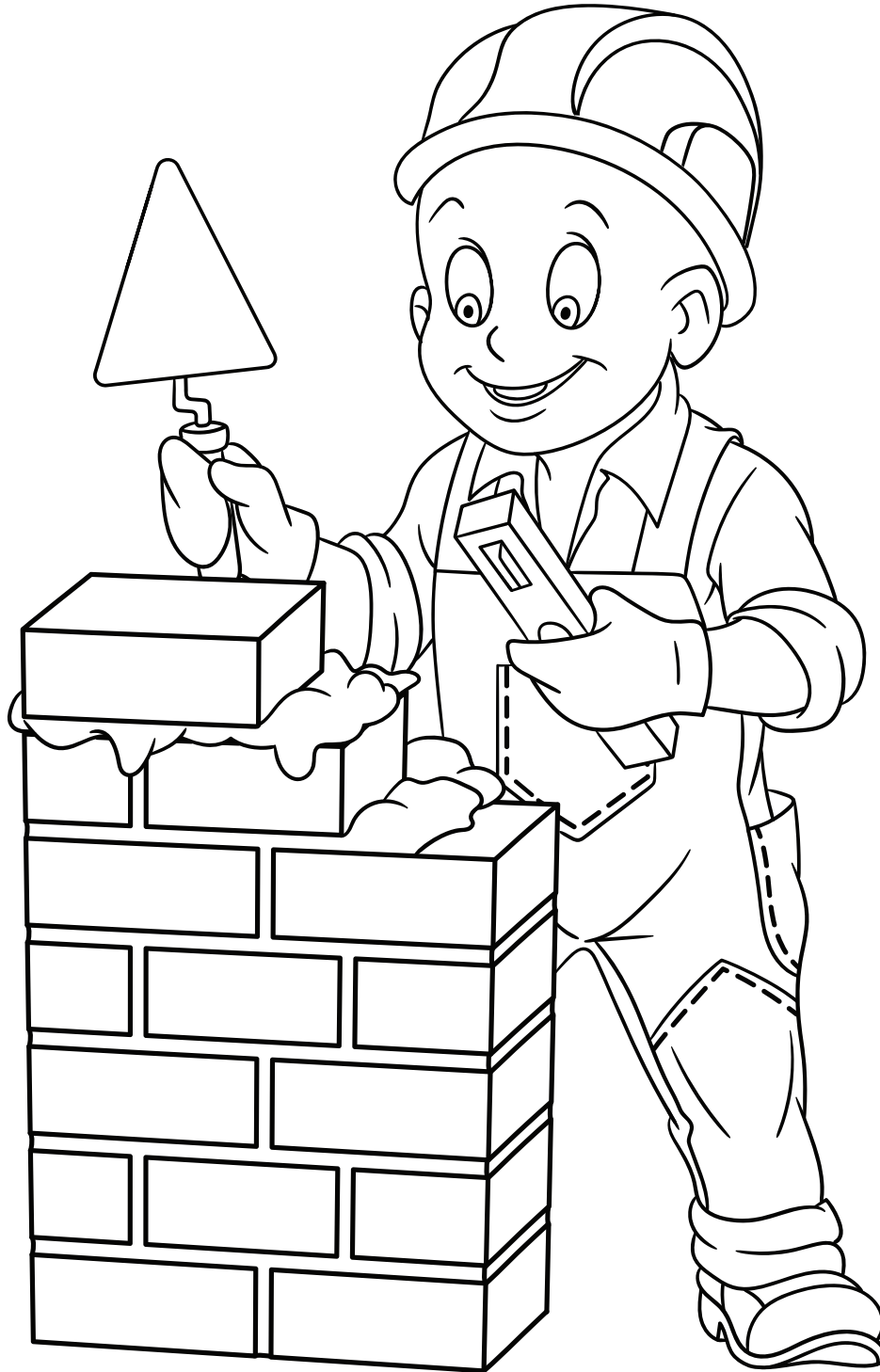

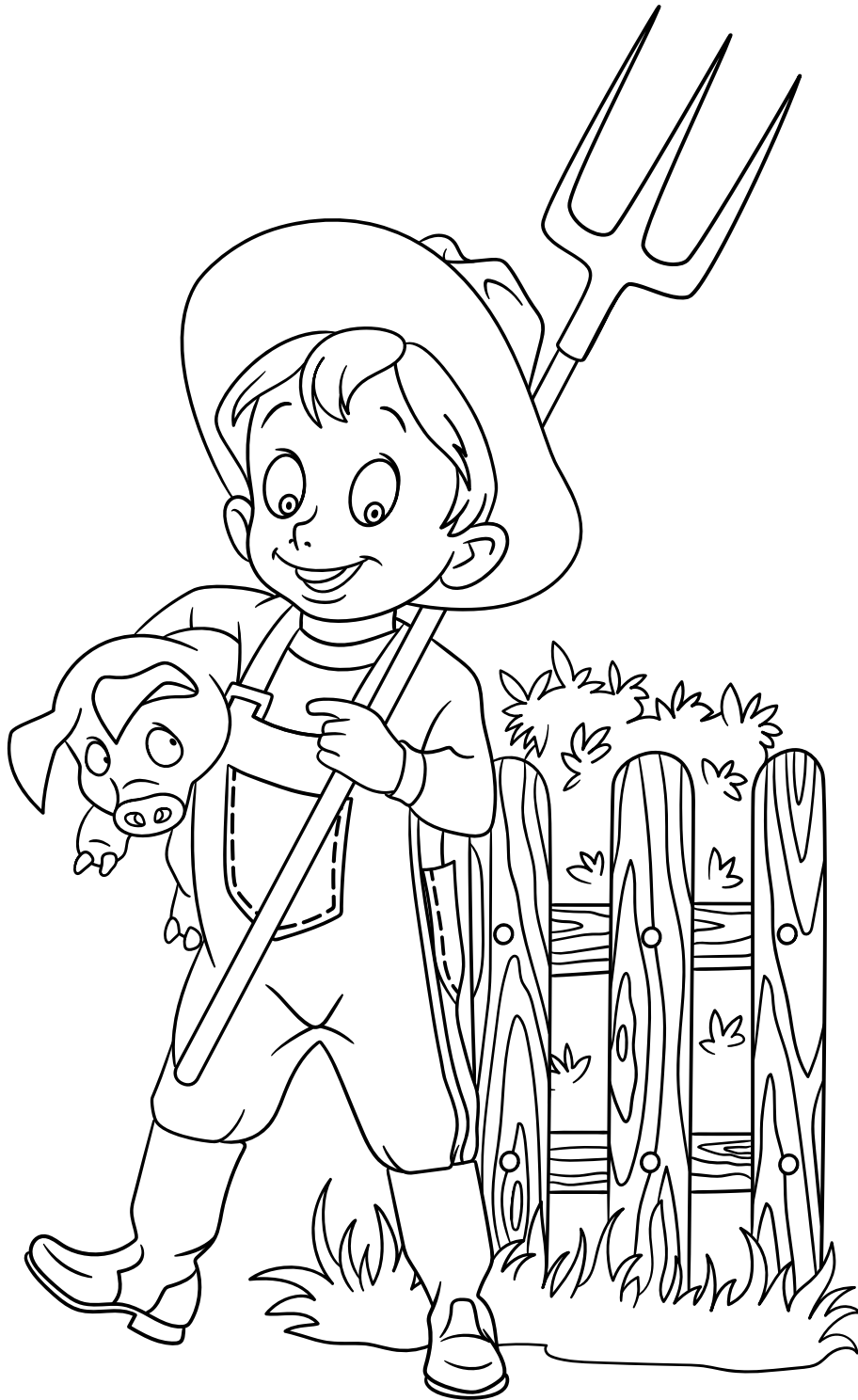

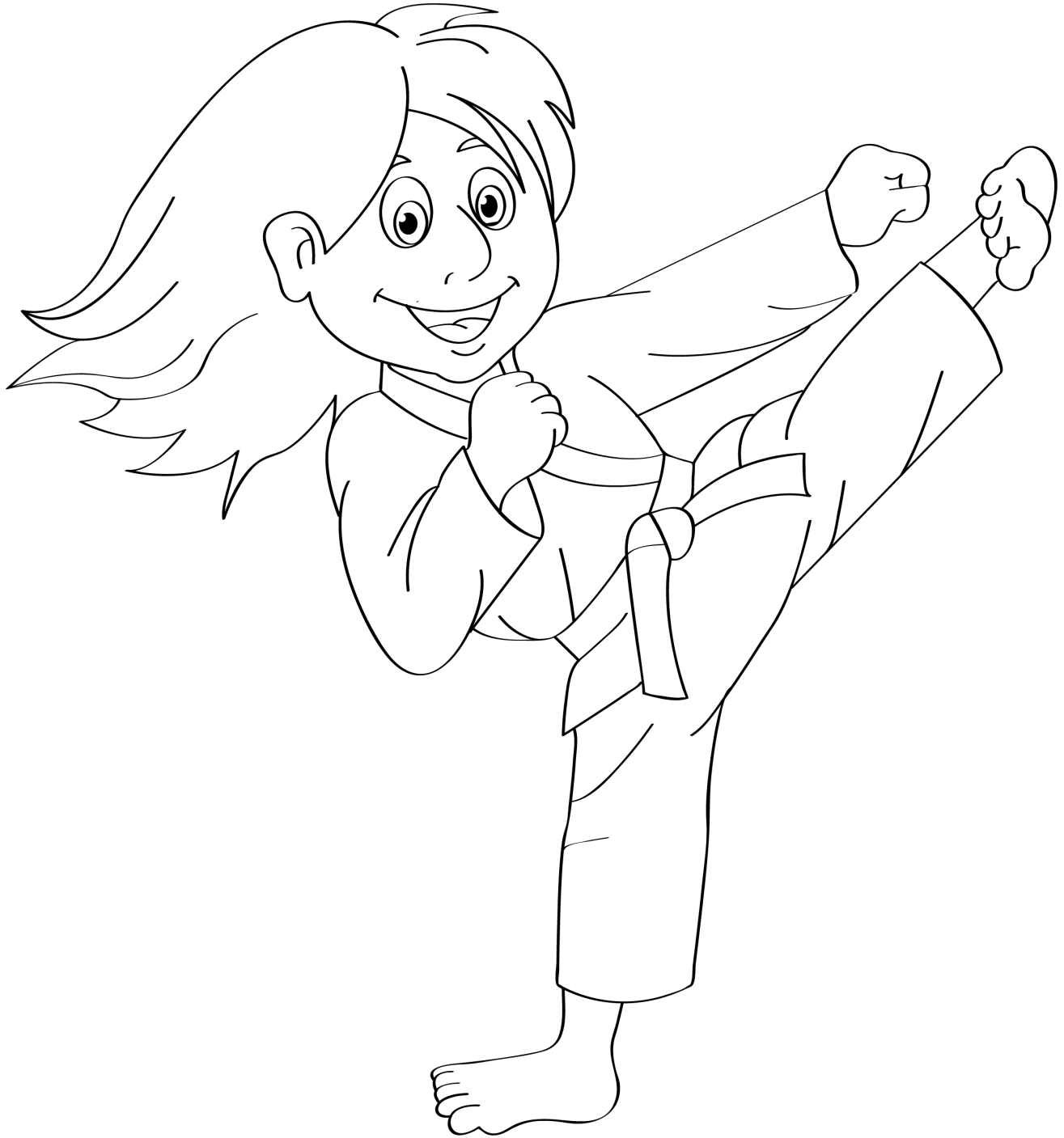

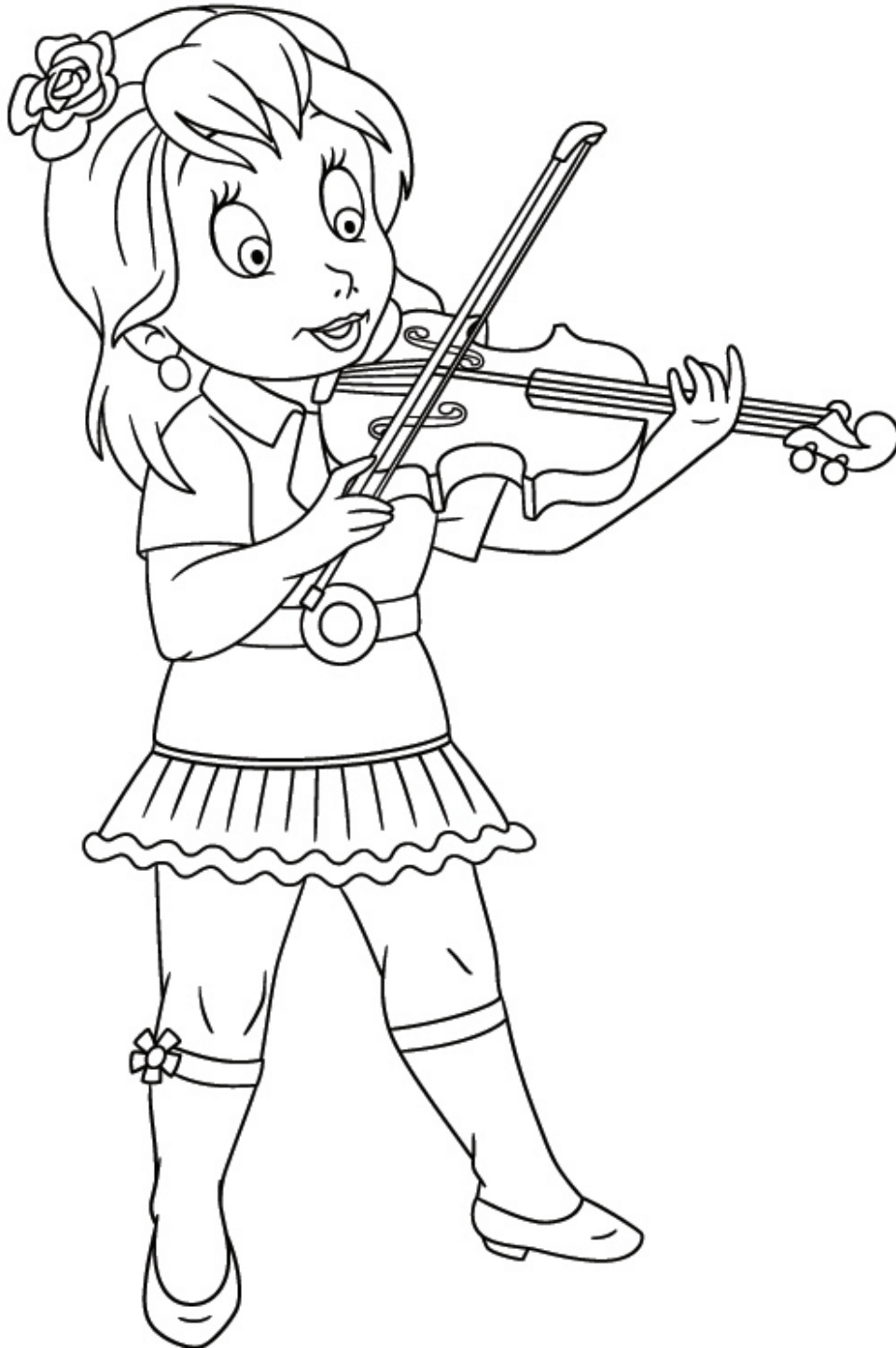

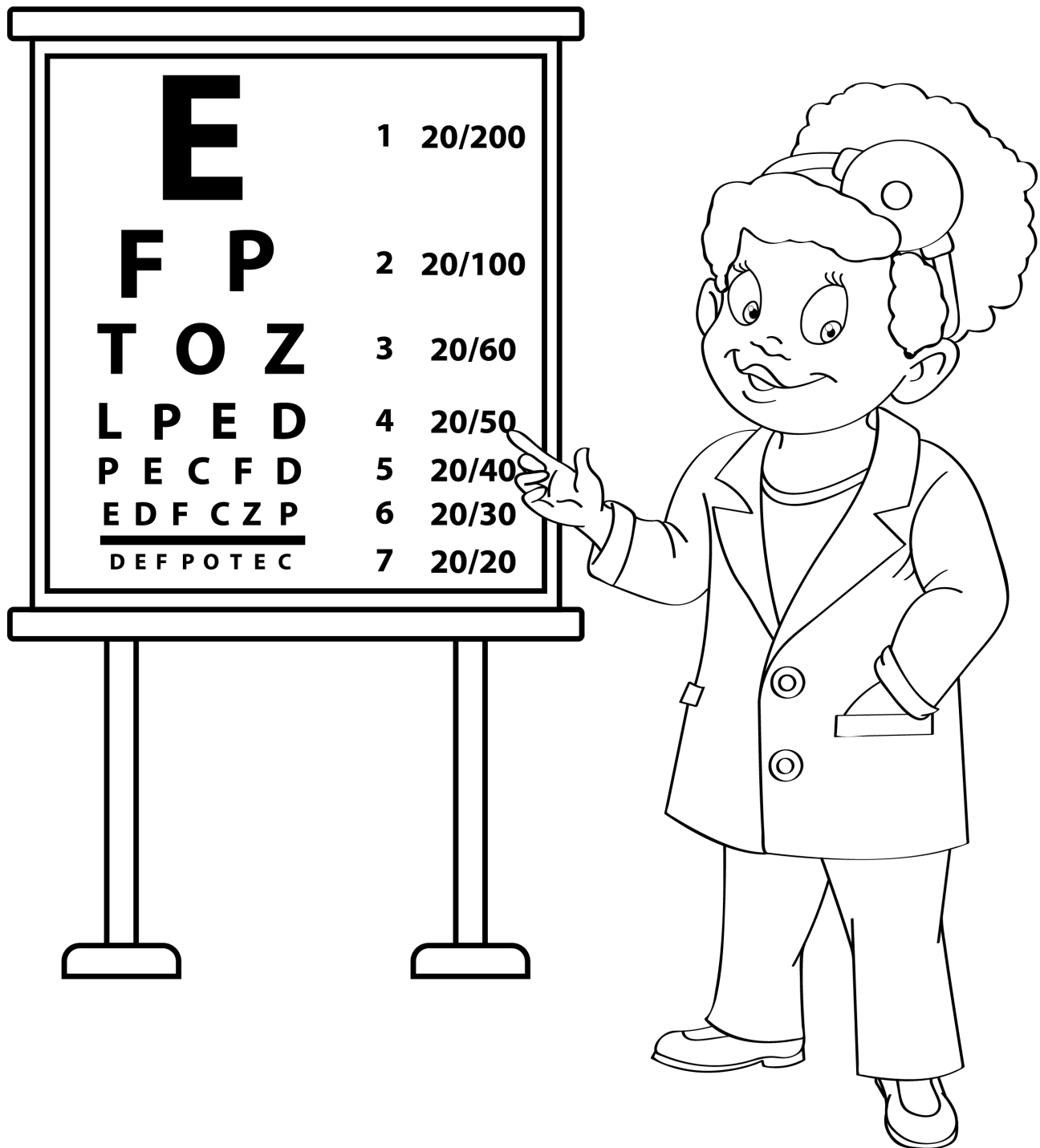

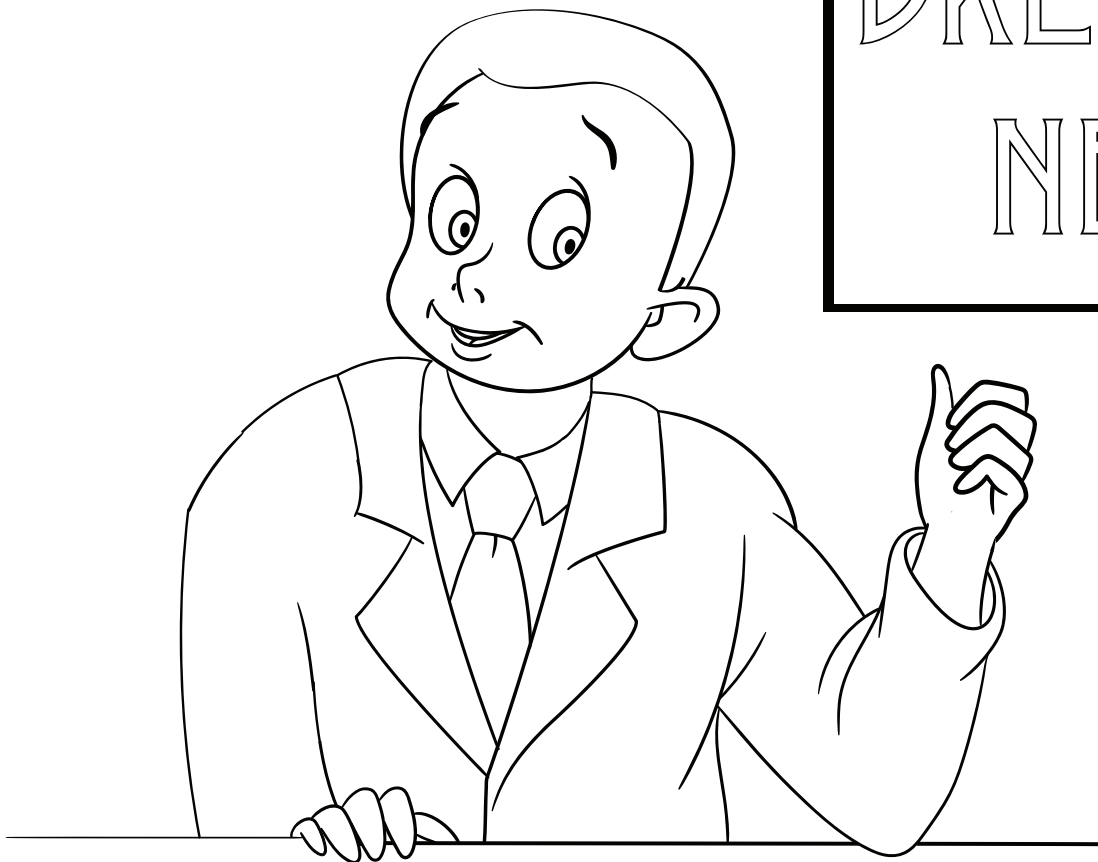

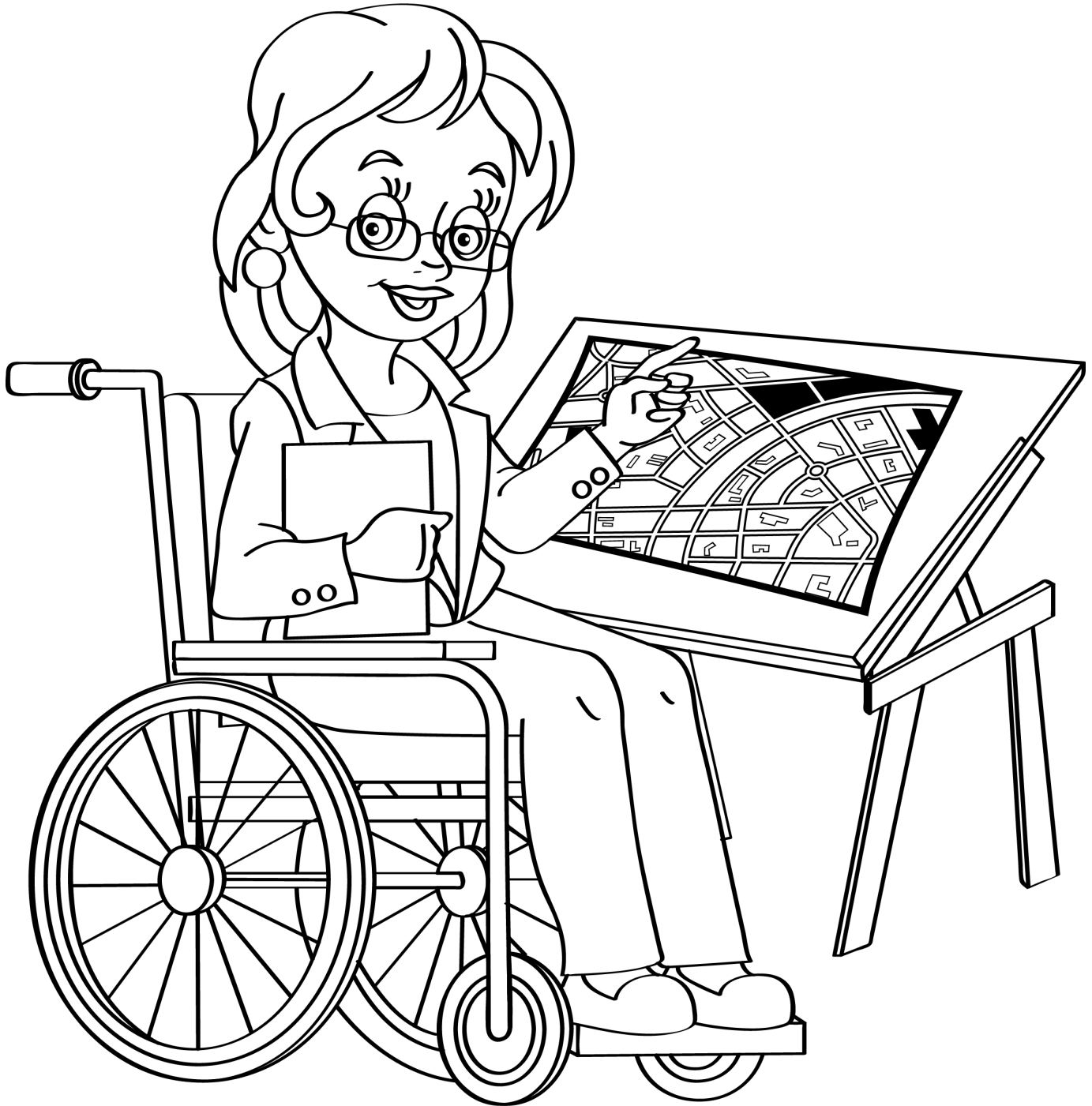

# V is for Veterinarian

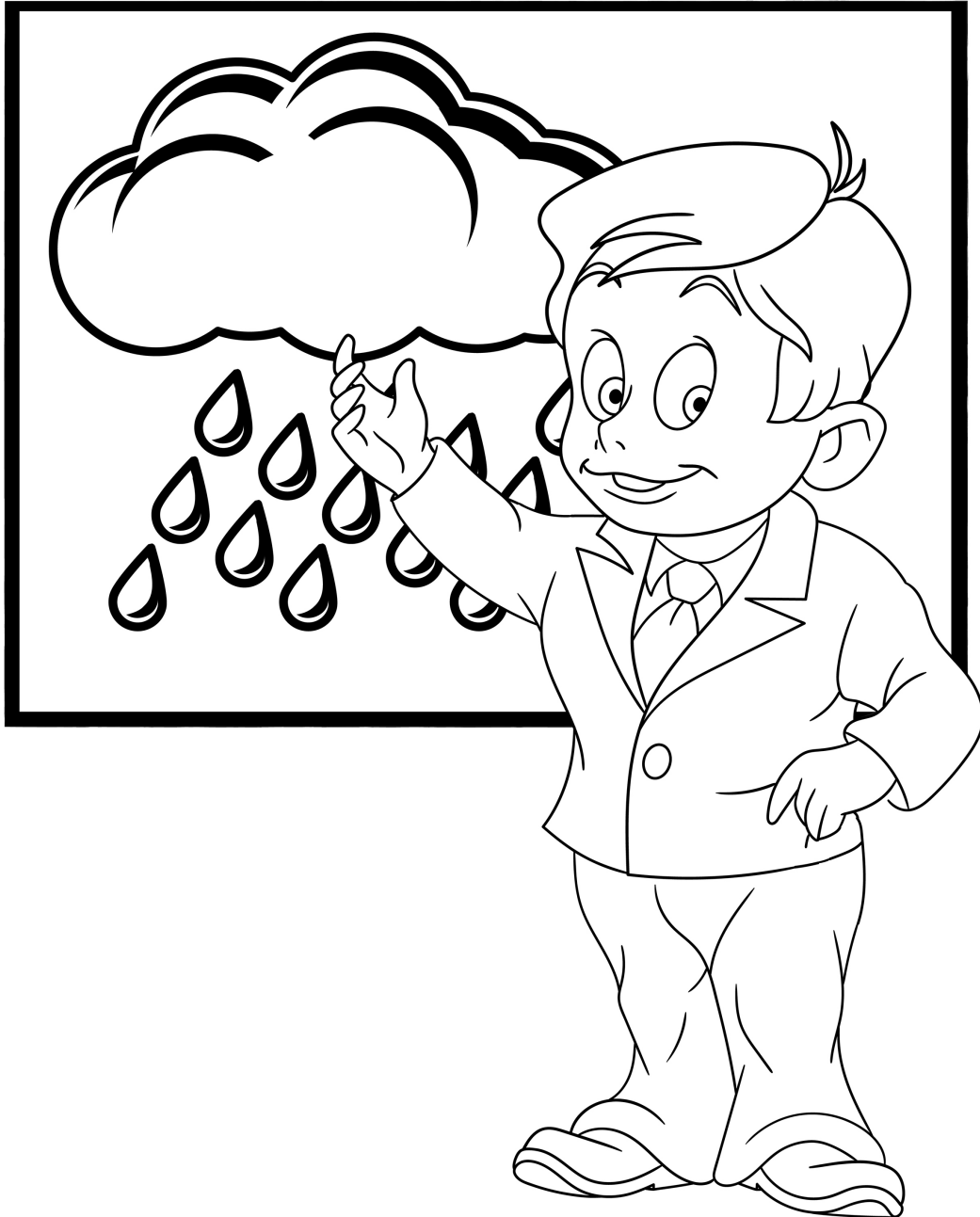

# W is for Weather Forecaster

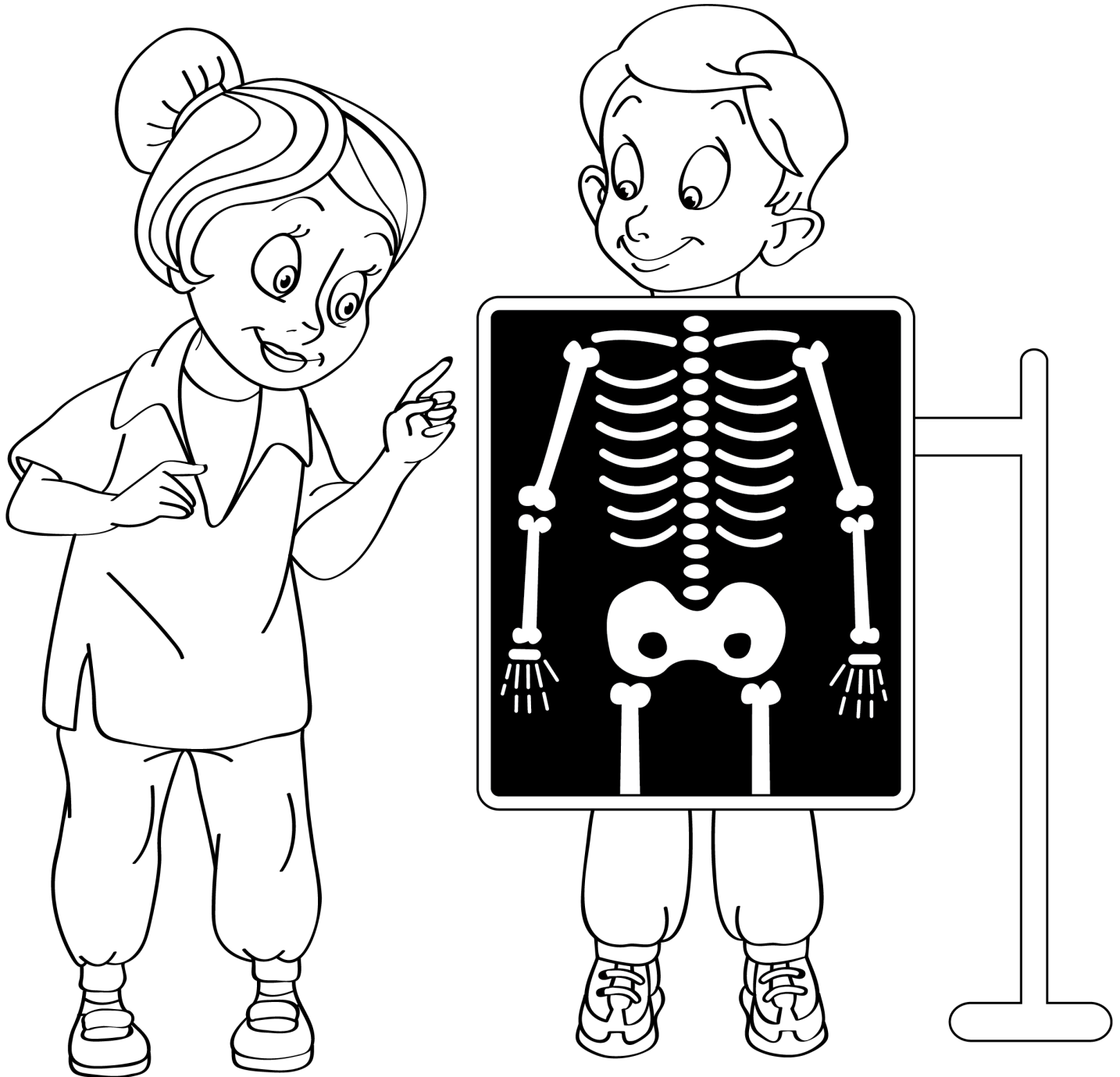

# X is for X-Ray Technician

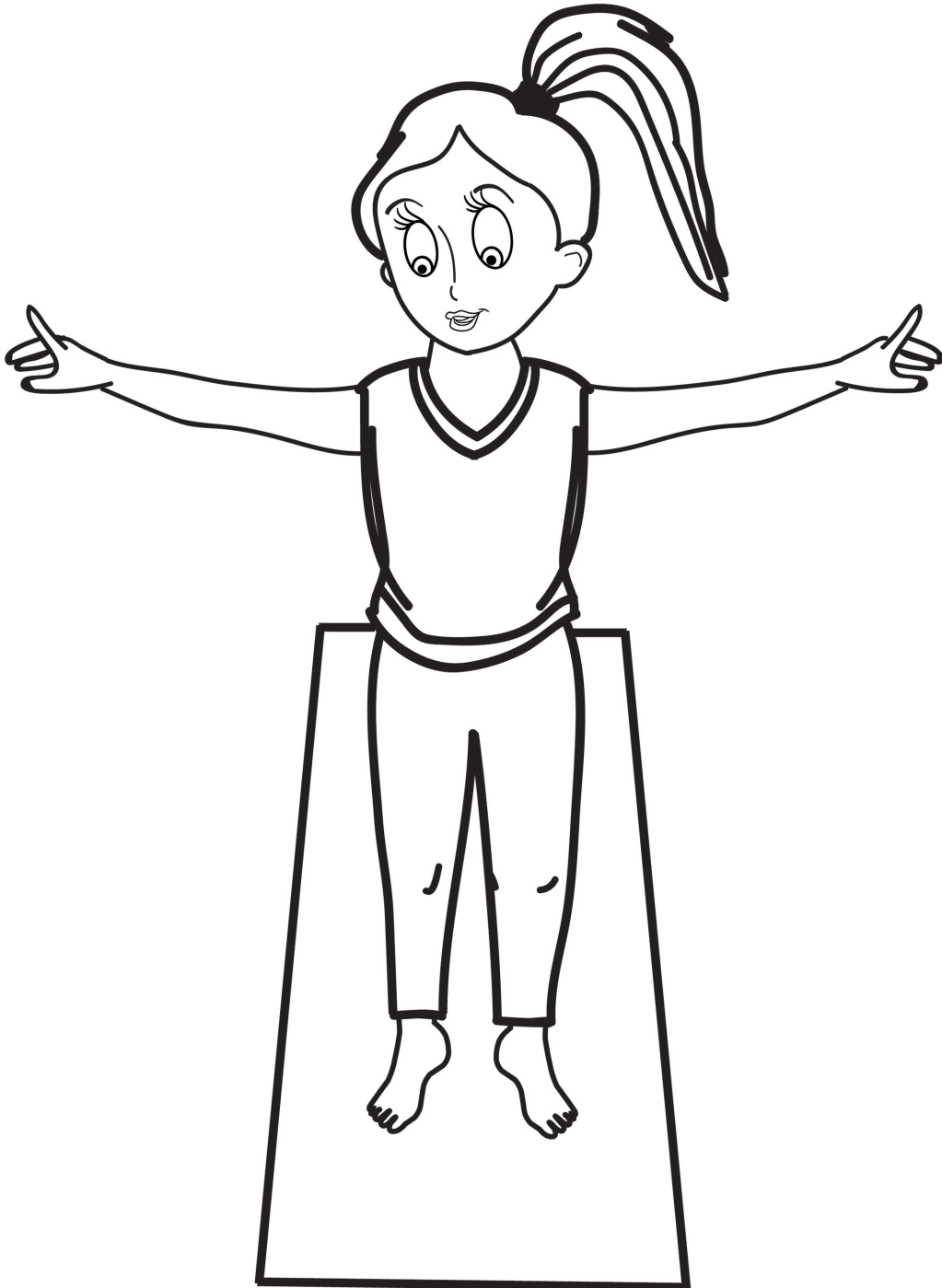
